Below is a proposed amendment to the current By-laws which will be presented to the membership for approval or rejection. You can pay in advance for your dinner and 2018 membership on the IHHPA website using PayPal.

Article XII (Amendments) of the IHHPA By-laws states: *This constitution and by-laws may be changed, altered or amended in any lawfully called and properly assembled meeting of the association membership only by the affirmative vote of the members present by a two-thirds (2/3) majority. Notice of proposed amendments shall be printed in the IHHPA Newsletter distributed the month prior to the scheduled Annual Meeting of the membership.* The following proposed amendment to the current By-laws will be presented at the 2017 Annual Meeting:

Proposed Amendment: Remove the first paragraph of Article V (Dues) and replace with the following:

The annual dues for men and women of this association shall be the current NHPA annual dues plus six dollars. Dues for one additional adult member living at the same address shall be the amount of the NHPA current annual dues. Limit of one additional adult per household. Junior membership is free. The IHHPA will pay the NHPA portion of the dues for all Juniors. The association dues card shall be issued for the calendar year January 1st through December 31st.

The change is needed because NHPA has raised its annual dues to \$25, effective with the 2018 memberships.

Plenty of sunshine and some breezy winds greeted the twenty-four players who showed up at Waterloo's Byrnes Park Courts on Saturday, July 1st for the Ralph Simon Memorial Tournament. On display were assortments of Ralph Simon's horseshoe pitching memorabilia. It included many of his awards, plaques, various documents, shirts, jackets and the first and last pair of shoes he pitched.

There were some very close matches in Class B, but Fort Dodge's Marty Sprague won the class with five straight wins - just barely though, as two of those wins came on the final pitch

of the game. Cedar Rapids John O'Shea was second. John also had the high percentage game for the class, hitting 50% with 12 ringers in 24 shoes in his game with Ricky Ellsworth.

Waterloo's Steve Faught won Class C honors going 4-2 and averaging 18.62%. He also had high game honors for the class with a 31.57% game. Al Kuntz of Mason City had the high average for the class, 21.81%, finishing in second place.

Heidi Kuecker of Waterloo swept all five of her games to take Class D honors. Her final game with Russ Wiese ended up tied 28-28 at 50 shoes then tied again 30-30 at 54 shoes. Russ went ahead by one point at 56 shoes, and then Heidi scored 4 on her last round and won. Her 19.82% average was high in the class and she also had the high percentage game 29.4%

In the afternoon session, the A-30 foot group, a four-man class, pitched a double round of 40 shoe games. Glenn Warden prevailed and won all six of his games with an average of 54.7%. Glenn also had the high game in the class throwing a couple of 60% games. The A-40 foot group was a five-man class. Jason Clark got the ringers when he needed them and won the Class with a 4-1 record, and a 44.68% average. Pat Simon had the high game for the class with a 65.63% game, hitting 21 of 32 shoes.

We welcomed a new member at the tournament, Keith Denton of Waverly. Keith is the first grandson of Ralph Simon and nephew to Pat Simon Sr. He pitched in this tournament using a part of Ralph Simon's old shoes that he had been given.
