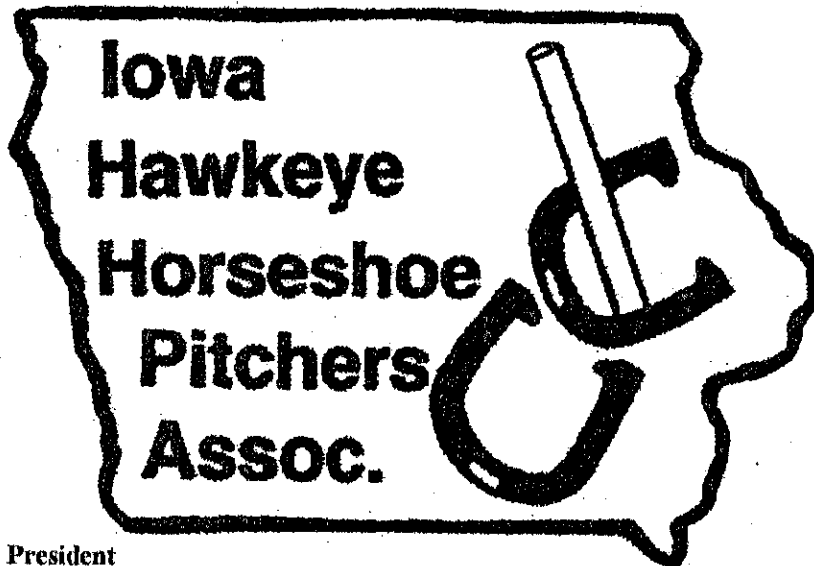

Many of their players are from Omaha and Eastern Nebraska. They tell me that there are not any courts in Omaha. This was a promotion type of tournament with no entry fee charged. The crowd really enjoyed this tournament. Weather was cool, with a full moon. The courts were filled.

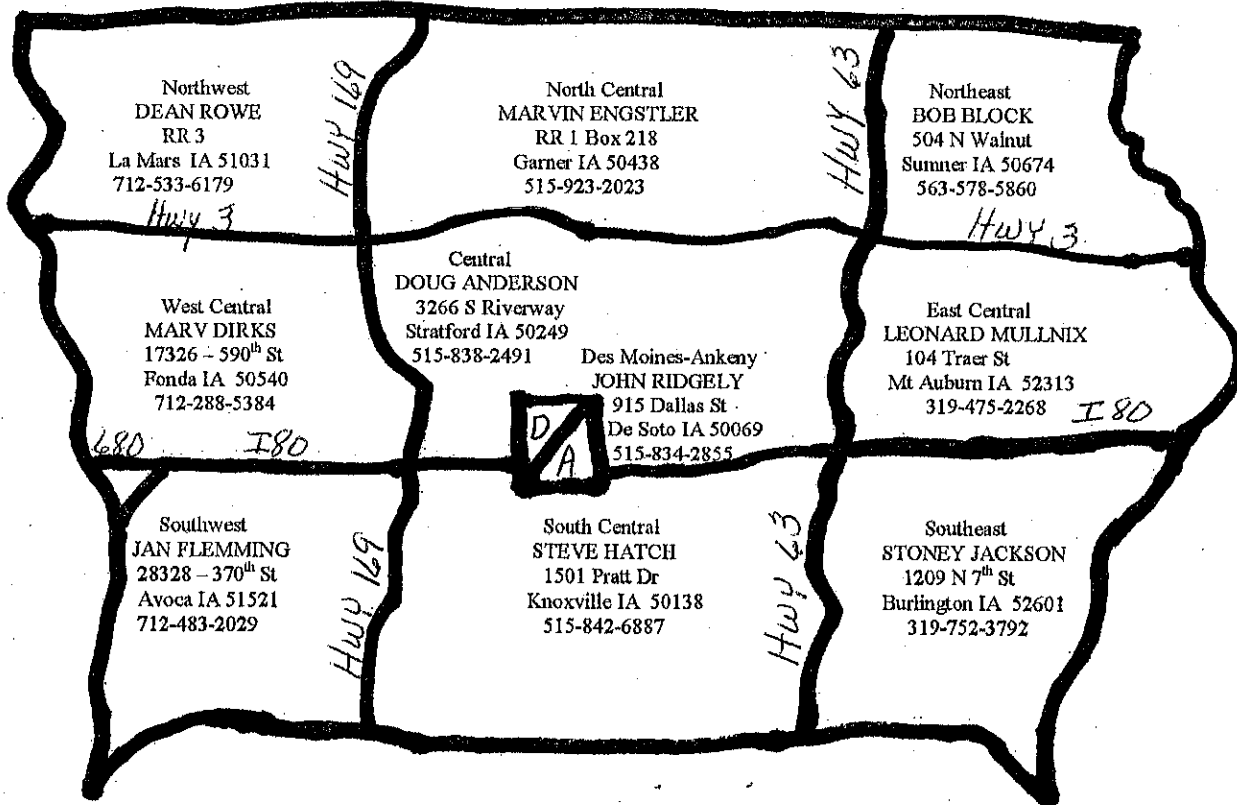

This is a great group of guys running this tournament and they really make you feel at home and appreciate you coming out for a visit.

We had the Hardin Fair on July 17th with open class and high low doubles in the afternoon. We had not promoted this quite like other years. After this tournament we had a tournament for Junior 4H boys and girls. We ended up with 20 some players. The highlight of the tournament, this group that just picked up the shoes, came out and at one time threw 3 straight ringers, so all we need to do is put those shoes in their hands and they had a great time. Next year we will have open shoe pitching for Jr's some time every day.

We also had Horseshoes for Kids. Used one of our courts from our indoor facility. Kids 4 years to 7 years. Each received a participation ribbon of our Hardin County Fair. Each kid pitched 10 shoes, we paid 5 cents for every point and 25 cents for every ringer. Gary Van Den Boom of our Club ran this and there was enough interest that we gave away \$15.00 worth of points and ringers. A lot of interest for young kids.

NHPF

In the June issue I expressed what the NHPF can do for you. Like everything else, it can't do anything without the membership's cooperation. The NHPF was set up to:

1. promote horseshoe in the U.S. and internationally as a recreational and amateur sport.
2. offer grants for construction of new courts and update some existing ones.
3. support junior horseshoe pitching programs, including scholarship awards for excelling in academics.
4. NHPF houses the Hall of Fame, plus 18 indoor courts and 20 covered courts, all excellent facilities. Some day a World Tournament may be held on site.

Todate only 17 different donations have been made from the State of Iowa to the NHPF. That is about 7 percent of our members. NHPF has been in existence for eight years. Iowa's total contribution for the past eight years is \$2606, or about \$325.00 a year. The NHPF can not continue to exist if more donations are not forth coming.

I would like to see all 240 Iowa members make a \$10.00 donation. This would nearly double our total contribution of the past. All donations are tax deductible. Let's do it. Send your donation to:

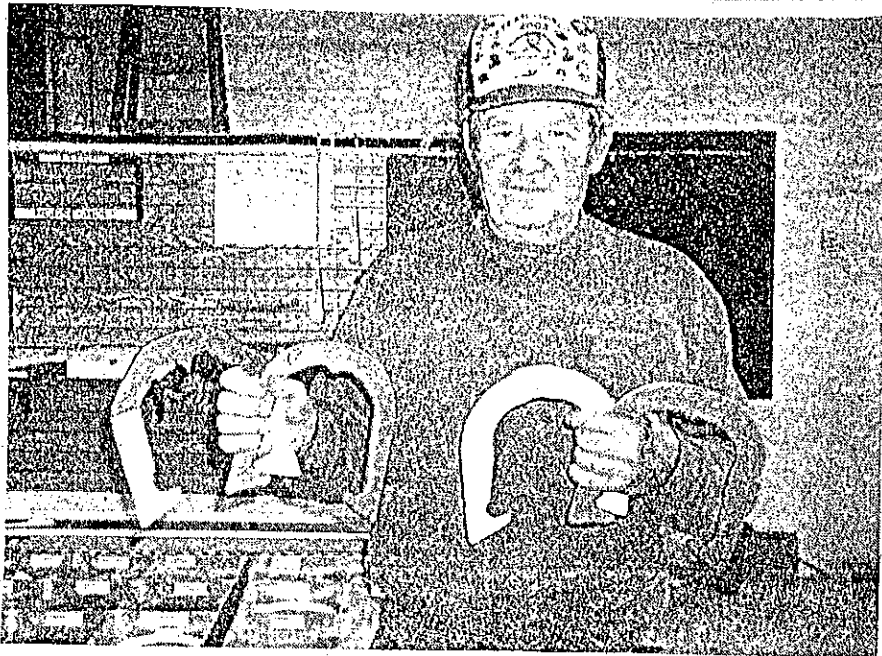
