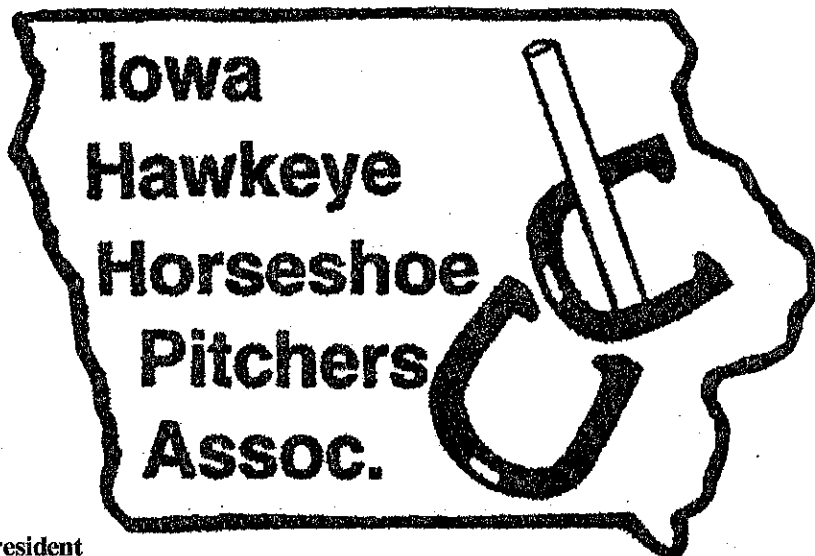

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE (I believe this is # 30!!!)

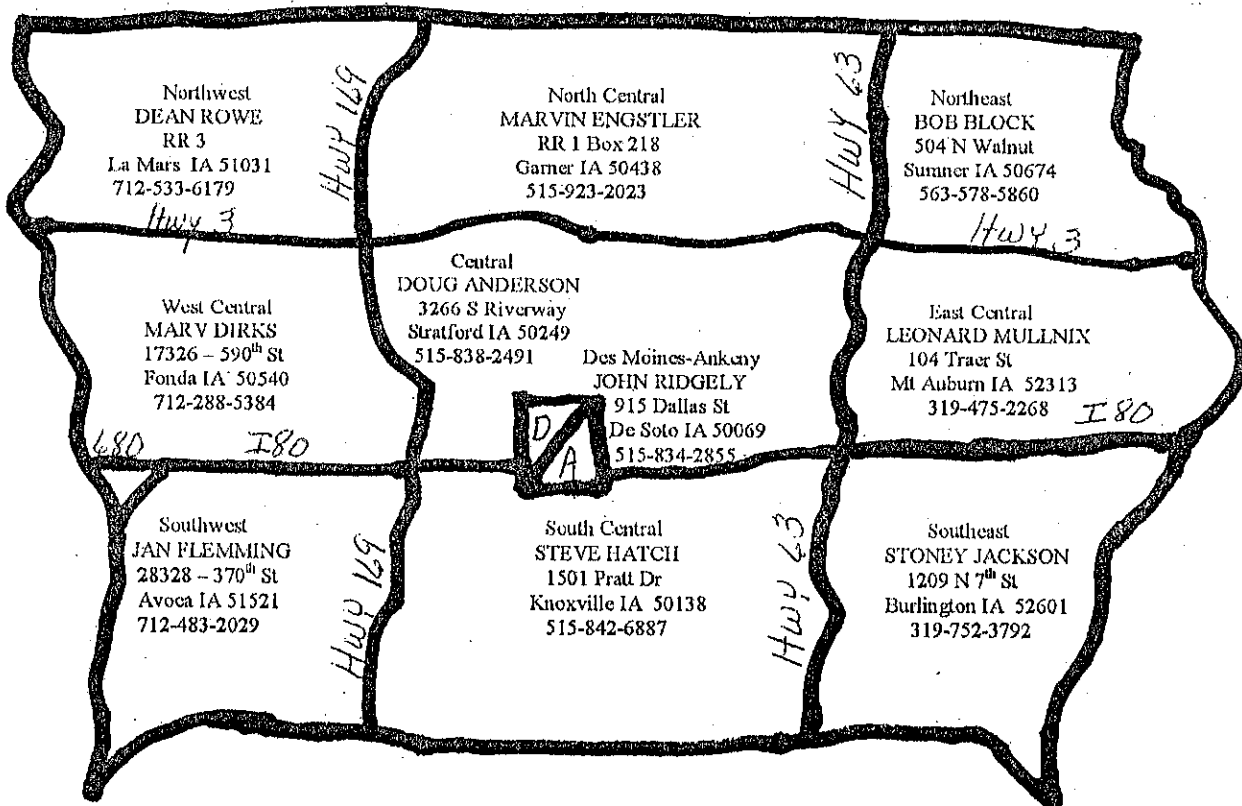

2003 IOWA STATE FAIR REPORT

Members of the Iowa Hawkeye Horseshoe Pitchers Association:

Thank you for supporting the Horseshoe event at the Iowa State Fair. Once again we had a record number of entries over the previous year. This is because of your support. This could not happen without you.

The Open Single event had 265 entries in 2003. In 2002 there were 166.

In the State Championship we had 87 entries compared to 69 in 2002.

There was a total of 558 entries at the Iowa State Fair in 2003, 69 more than last year. The number of players that made up the 558 entries was 254. 126 non-members and 128 NHPA/IHHPA members.

The weather was good until the last three days. We would have had more entries except that the weather the last 3 days was extremely hot. 4 people had to withdraw because of the heat in the championship round. Also Ron Utley broke his foot on the last day. Many of you put up with the extreme heat with few complaints. Thank you.

This was the first Iowa State Fair completely put on a computer. Thanks to the very good help that we had in the tent. Also the groundskeepers did a great job. We had 20 new scoreboards built by the Iowa State Fair maintenance employees. The secretary-Treasurer, Dave Sidles, of this association was a great help. Thanks go to Bob Walters, President for his help. Many others also helped.


On the courts we had the Iowa State Fair Queen and also Fairfield, of the Iowa State Fair, paid us a visit. Presidential hopeful, Senator Dick Gephardt pitched horseshoes with us. Glen Henton and Marion Lange also paid us a visit. On the last Saturday, an exhibition was put on at the Bill Riley stage. We gave away 6 pair of new horseshoes in our drawing and 3 sets at the exhibition. A big thanks to all for a job well done. We got a picture of everyone except the Senator. The memory book will be in the Hall of Fame trailer at the next Iowa State Fair.

The Iowa State Fair would like to have the Iowa State Tournament again next year at the Iowa State Fair. The World Tournament will end on August 7th in 2004 and the 2004 Iowa State Fair will begin on August 12th and end August 22nd. This will be the 150th year for the Iowa State Fair and we want you there. Please remember all the money paid out by the Iowa State Fair and the great help they have given us to put this horseshoe event on.
