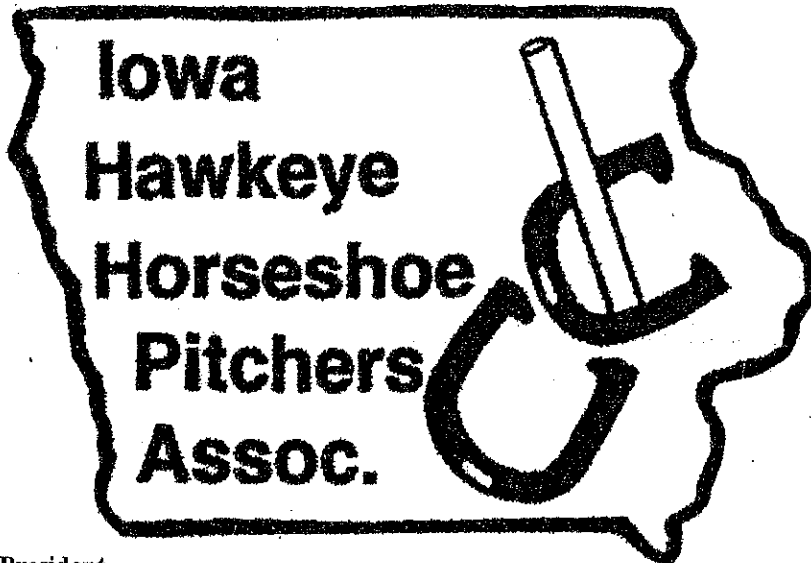

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

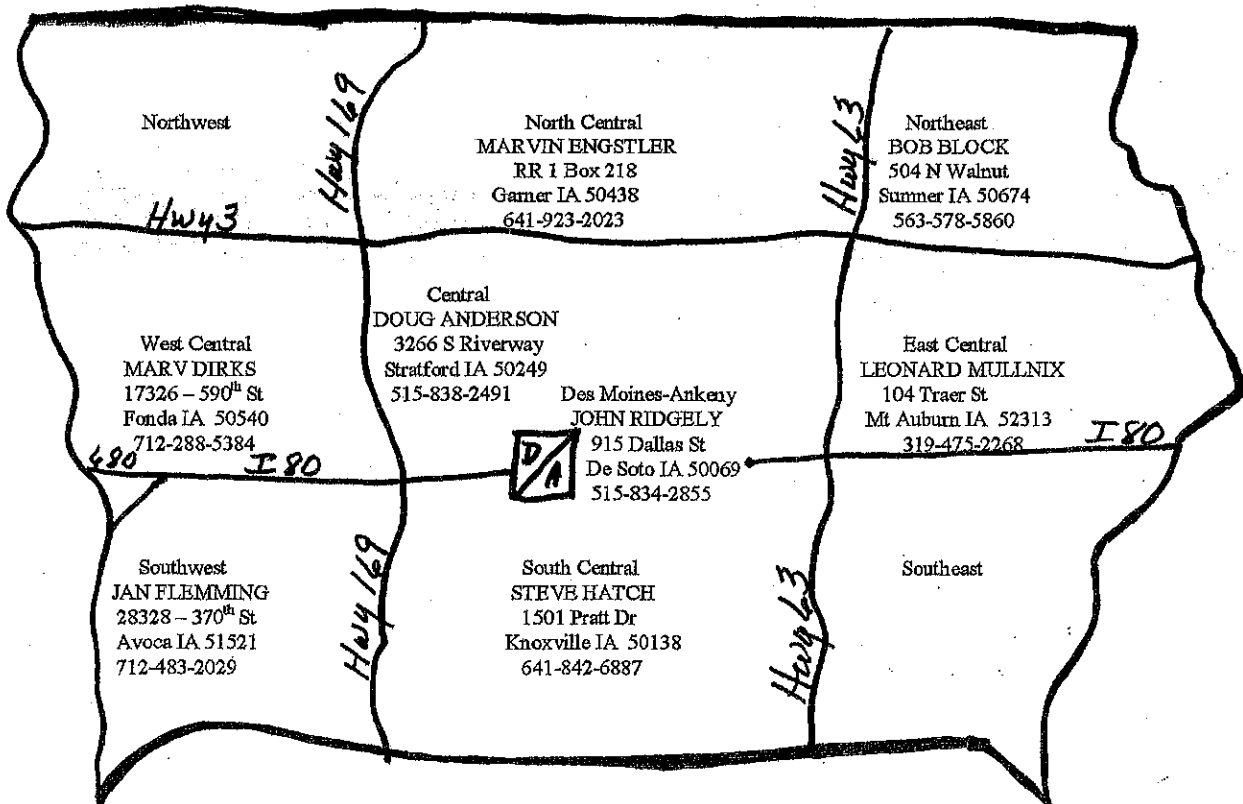

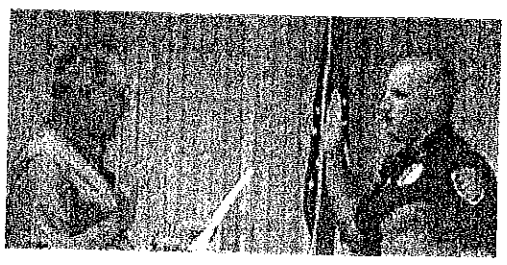
IN MEMORY



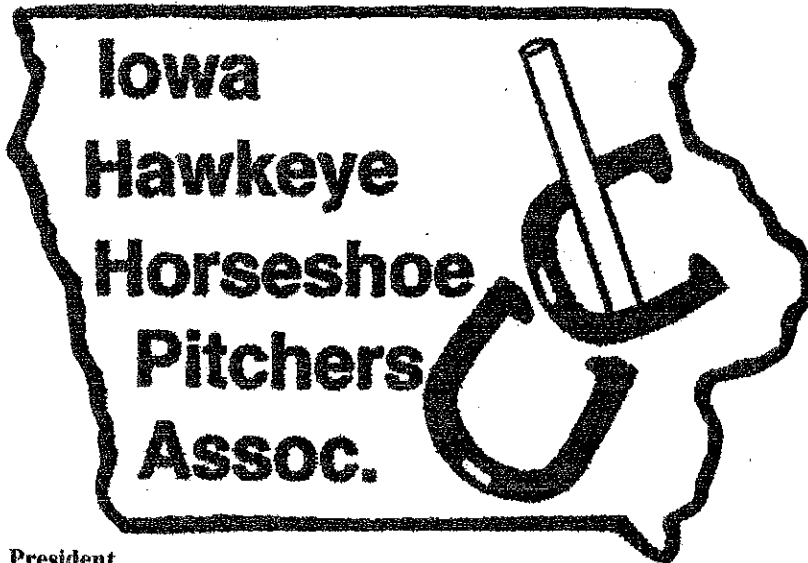

Major events coming up are the Iowa Games, the World Tournament and the Iowa State Fair. I want to wish all of those traveling to California for the World Tournament the best of luck. Hope you all come back winners and have a great time.

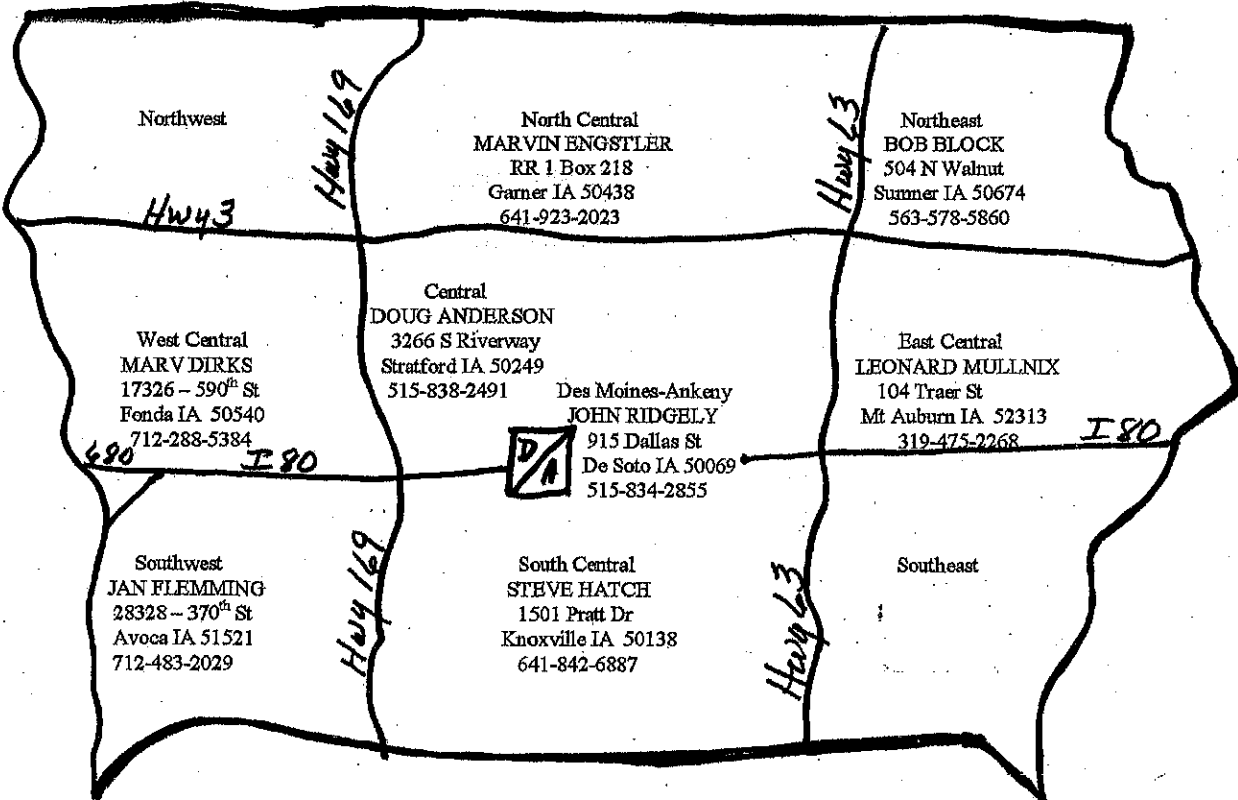
A couple of issues have been brought to my attention. I would like to clarify some points of contention. Most of our tournaments are not pre-registered. I do realize that we have gotten in the habit of phoning ahead to the tournament director if we are coming and think we will be late. However, we must realize that if our class should play in the morning and we are not there at the appointed tournament starting time, the tournament will start without us. By the same token, if a pitcher calls ahead for directions and only indicates they may be there, we should not hold up a tournament for their arrival. We all know things come up and plans have to be changed.

A few years ago at the annual meeting, the members decided that since most everyone has a computer and accessibility to the internet, it was not cost effective for the Regional Director or Statistician to send the tournament directors each members current address as they are available through Natstats. Our Regional Director will pull this information from Natstats and forward it to the tournament director if they notify him they do not have accessibility to this information.

The nice thing about Natstats is that if you are having a tournament in a town that borders another state, you can also pull the information from that state so you are prepared for any pitchers that enter your tournament. Also available is your individual tournaments that you have played in the last 12 months. A good way to check your average and see if you agree.

Hope to see lots of you at the Iowa games.
