

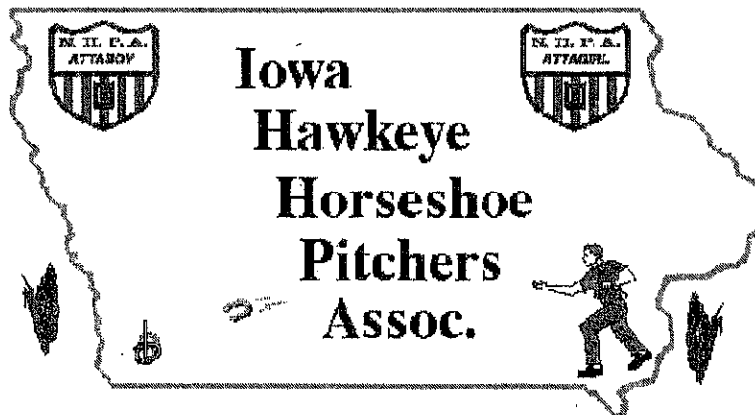

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

**NHPA EXECUTIVE BOARD SELECTS YORK, PA TO HOST
2008 WORLD TOURNAMENT**

At the NHPA Executive Board Meeting held in Ardmore, Oklahoma on Jan. 20th, York, Pennsylvania was selected as the site of the 2008 World Tournament. Springfield, Illinois and Cedar Rapids, Iowa also gave presentations. The basis of their decision was that it has been a long time since a World Tournament had been held on the East Coast. The IHHPA will continue to pursue the bid for the 2009 World Tournament in Cedar Rapids. Another bid will be made at the Business meeting at this year's World Tournament in Ardmore, Oklahoma. Normally delegates vote on WT sites two years in advance. The 2008 WT was awarded by the NHPA Ex Board due to Alabama having to withdraw as the tournament site

IOWA STATE FAIRGROUNDS NEW COURT LOCATION

State Fair Superintendent Danny Sease and I attended a recent meeting to discuss where the new courts would be relocated. The space within the Fairgrounds to place the courts is limited. They presented three possible sites for our consideration. After discussing, we looked at all three sites. Originally, the Fair Planning Committee had planned for ten courts. We explained to them that we needed a minimum of twelve courts. It became evident that the best location

was located adjacent to Pioneer Hall just East of the Hall and next to the Campgrounds. The ground is now used for parking. Many people visit Pioneer Hall and the people from the campgrounds will also generate spectators and new players. The Fair Planning Committee will need to determine if adding two more courts to their original plan of ten will allow them to finalize this site as the new location. While this site is some distance from the parking lot, there are rides available from the parking lot to where the Ye Old Mill is and from there the tractor pulled shuttle and take you to Pioneer Hall. There will be shade trees and full walkways - - no asphalt. We will keep you informed if this site is selected.

PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED MEN

Male pitchers less than seventy years old may be given permission to move onto the extended platforms and observe the twenty-seven-foot foul lines. If you know of someone who has a permanent disability and would like to continue or resume pitching at the shorter distance, encourage them to contact Ron Rowley, IHHPA Secretary/Treasurer, to obtain a "Medical Exemption Form." The procedure is now in place for the IHHPA Executive Board to grant or deny such requests.

**IHHPA HALL OF FAME
CHET FOSTER**

Chet Foster of Ankeny, Iowa, was inducted posthumously into the Iowa Hawkeye Horseshoe Pitchers Association (IHHPA) Hall of Fame last year.

Chet Foster spent his youth in the Kellerton, Iowa area where he was taught the game of horseshoes by his father, who had been taught by World Champion Frank Jackson.

Chet was a charter member of the Central Iowa Traveling League. He spent many years as Iowa State Fair Superintendent, Director for the NHPA Central Regional Tournaments, and Director of the Marion Lange Open in Des Moines. Due to Chet's encouragement, Earl Winston brought the National Hall of Fame to the Iowa State Fair for many years.

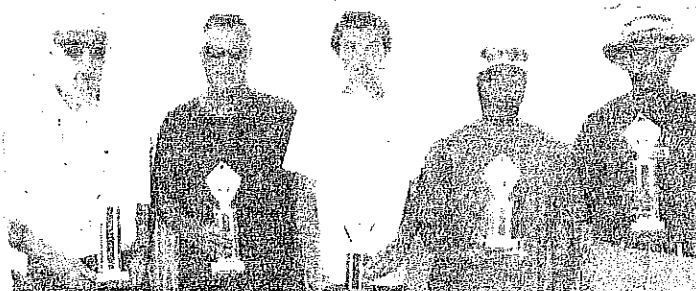
Chet donated much of his personal time to the game of horseshoes. He was always available to donate time when anyone wanted a demonstration of the game. He put together demonstrations for the Boy Scouts, the handicapped, and in small towns. In later years, he helped his brother, Farrell, and Barry Jackson's father with the installation of the courts in Kellerton.

Chet was nominated by the late Don Wilson, and Mic Wilson, and Dick Carlson confirmed the nomination. Dick then made several attempts to contact Chet's family to let them know of Chet's award. Bobbie Sease provided Dick with Chet's obituary showing the names of his two sons, Ron and Jerry, and his daughter, Kathy. But it wasn't until Dick contacted the Jacksons of Kellerton, Iowa, that he was able to get in touch with Chet's three children. Dick and IHHPA Secretary/Treasurer, Ron Rowley, are meeting with Chet's family in Ankeny to award the Hall of Fame plaque and to get a photo of Chet for the Hall of Fame Trailer.

Chet passed away in 2001. He was a retired employee of Perishable Distributors of Iowa (PDI) in Ankeny.
