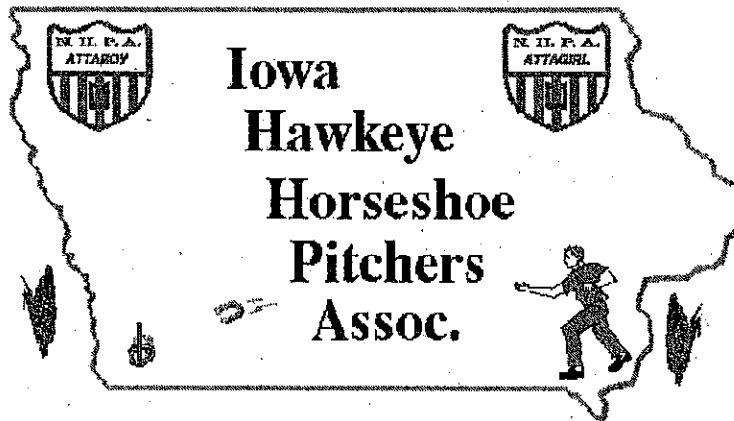

Bob Walters, Secretary-Treasurer for the Eldora Horseshoe Club of Central Iowa, called the meeting to order. He proceeded to provide each player with a copy of the results and pictures of the first indoor horseshoe pitching tournament of the Iowa Games for the Year 2000. He stated that Dick Carlson, at the Iowa Games in Ames, said they would be back at Eldora's Putt Mossman Indoor Arena the last Saturday in January, 2008.

Bob Walters then furnished every player with a nine-page booklet on the history of the workings of the Eldora Horseshoe Club of Central Iowa. He then proceeded to announce that current President Morris Lepley was not wanting to be active in the Club as President, but still wanted to be a member. Bob then appointed Russ Martin to be Acting President for this meeting.

Member and Director Joe Lepley was not present and could not be contacted by telephone.

Bob Walters then announced that the main business for the day was to have November and December tournaments at the Putt Mossman Indoor Arena and that Russ Martin, Director, had volunteered his services as Tournament Director for those two months and any other dates that the Club needed help.

Russ Martin, Acting President, asked for comments and any disagreements on this proposal. None were received and Eldora Horseshoe Club will have tournaments in November and December, and tournaments for 2008, as our schedule is completed.

Bob Walters thanked the players for the intent in this matter.

## CONDOLENCES

WILLIAM VIGARS  
1918 - 2007

William H. "Bill" Vigars, 88, of Eldora, died Saturday, June 30, 2007, at Mary Greeley Medical Center in Ames, Iowa. Bill was born August 18, 1918, at home on the farm in rural Hardin County, the son of William Chester and Blanche "Bea" Vigars. He received his education in Eldora, graduating from Eldora High School in 1935. On January 13, 1942, he entered the United States Air Force and served his county during World War II, until he was honorably discharged in November 1945.

Bill was a lifelong farmer and made his home, along with his wife Leona, on their farm in rural Eldora. In 1980, they moved off the farm and into Eldora. Bill enjoyed bowling, horseshoe pitching, gardening and playing bridge.

Bill was one of our veteran Eldora Horseshoe pitchers. He was active in our fund drive in bringing indoor horseshoes to Eldora and the State of Iowa.

Bill had many interest in life besides horseshoe pitching. He was a topnotch farmer and dairyman. He probably did more shovel work than any person I have known. We were on the same wrestling team and his Dad and two other dads would drive our team to different town meets. This was a fun time for us and the team. When we came home, win or lose, we would have a steak dinner at some restaurant, like Stones Cafe when we came through Marshalltown --- and the Dads paid!

When Bill's mother passed away he asked me to sell her home. I brought him a buyer that he liked - - a school teacher. The buyer didn't have much money but Bill made a proposal so the teacher could buy it, and they were friends ever since.

We are going to miss Bill as he was someone special. He worked in the Turnabout Shop three days a week. I would go over and shoot the breeze with him. It was always good to bring up the many things we have seen change since we were kids.

Bill was a guy of many talents. When he passed away, horseshoes were not forgotten as he had his shoes and his box in front of him, along with his favorite fishing lure. One of his mementos was the Eldora Indoor Championship purple rosette that said, "I pitched in the 2000 Indoor Horseshoe Pitching Championships at Hardin County Community Building on the Hardin County Fairgrounds, Eldora, Iowa."

Bill is survived by his wife, Leona Vigars of Eldora; two sons, Bryan Vigars and Jim Vigars; one daughter, Becky Vigars; four grandchildren; four great grandchildren, and one sister, Dorothy Pardun of Roseville, Minnesota. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Geneva.

Glenn Warden hosted a non-sanctioned tournament in Mitchellville on Saturday, July 21<sup>st</sup>. After making a few phone calls, Glenn had eighteen players at the Mitchellville Courts.

**IHHPA HALL OF FAME  
DALE DIXON**

Dale Dixon was from Des Moines, Iowa. He was a physically strong man, a former general contractor who designed and manufactured the Dixon Victory horseshoe which was sanctioned by the NHPA. He sawed horseshoes out of sheet steel with a band saw.

Dale also built and sold portable horseshoe courts. He was the first pitcher to introduce portable courts at the State Fair. The courts were used in the cattle barn from 1968 to 1973. The portable courts used springs underneath a rubber. The courts could travel in the back of a pickup or trunk of a car and then be set up anywhere without the need for pit material. Because they were clean, they could be set up indoors for demonstrations or as practice courts when traveling. Vicky Winston and Dean Carter still own a set of Dale's portable courts.

In 1953, Keith Baker saw Dale pitching at a tournament. Keith was throwing a ¾ turn at the time. When he met Dale and saw the success Dale was having with a 1 and ¾ turn, Keith went to that pitch and has stayed with it ever since.

Dale participated in over 50 national tournaments across the country. He had a composite record of 69.7% in World tournaments, and an average qualifying score of 500 (qualifying was 200 shoes count-all). In the Men's Championship class, he finished as high as sixth place in two different years - - 1946, pitching 69.6% and 1958, pitching 72.62%. He pitched against such legends as Ted Allen and Harold Reno. He was the Iowa State Champion 11 times between years 1941-1959. Only Glen "Red" Hinton has won more Iowa state championships, winning 18 times.

In 1972, Dale pitched in his last national tournament, pitching in the Men's Intermediate Class. He placed 4<sup>th</sup>, pitching 62.13%. It was the same year that a kid named Walter Ray Williams, Jr. pitched 89.21% to take the Junior's Championship.

Dale is a charter member of the IHHPA Hall of Fame. He served as President of the NHPA from 1953-1955. He was elected to the National Hall of Fame in 1973 as a promoter. He was instrumental in getting at least two World Tournaments to Des Moines which were held at the corner of East 14<sup>th</sup> & Grand Avenue.

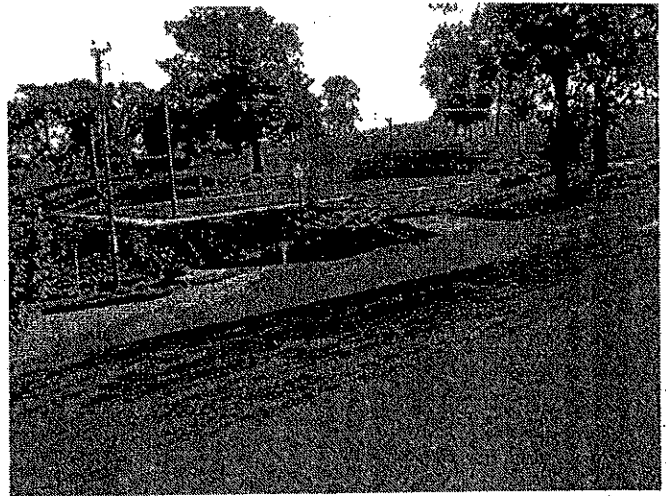
