

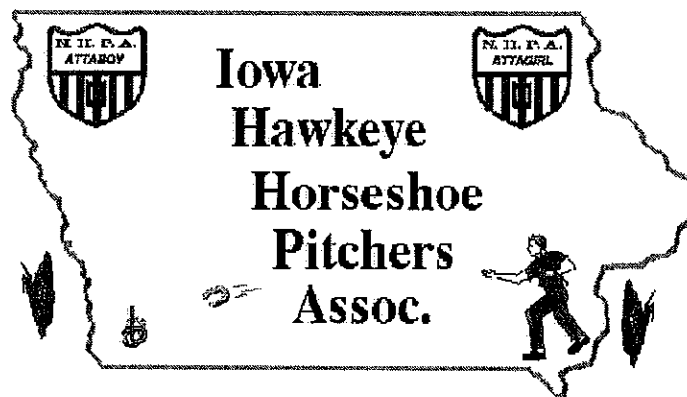

“1,261 WORLD TOURNAMENT ENTRIES”
Ninety IHHPA Members will be competing!

WOW! Almost half of our membership will be in Cedar Rapids for the biggest horseshoe pitching event of the year, the National Horseshoe Pitchers Association's *WORLD TOURNAMENT*. Ralph Palmer, Host Tournament Director, and WT Committee members have been putting in a lot of time and effort in preparing for this event. There is much more to accomplish and the Tournament is drawing nearer each day. We will need to ramp up our efforts to obtain advertisers for the Tournament Program. The half-way point has been reached in finding court sponsors and we will need your help finding sponsors for the remaining courts. The court sponsorship forms have been in the Newsletters and can be found on our website, ihhpa.com.

In addition to using the Ellis Park facility for practice, six new courts are being constructed at the Amana Colonies. The courts are located in the Northeast corner of the Amana RV/Campgrounds. This is a joint project with the Amana Campgrounds providing all construction material and IHHPA members providing the

labor and clay for the courts. The clay will be the same clay that will be used in the World Tournament pits. Bob Hardy has done a wonderful job in planning and seeing that this court complex will be ready for the many campers who will be staying there during the World Tournament. The Amana Colonies is one of our major sponsors.

Those of you who have entered will be receiving your playing schedule and Entrant Information in the mail around June 7th. If you would like an estimate as to when you will be playing, or have other questions, call me in the evenings at (515) 681-1937. To those of you who could not enter this year's WT, but would like to see the Championship Classes play, this competition will take place during the last three days of the Tournament.

Looking forward to another great eleven days of pitching at the Iowa State Fair this year. The Fair pitching schedule is posted on our website and has been included with previous Newsletters. The State Championships will again be held on the two weekends during the Fair. Take time to fill out the entry form and send it in.

IHHPA HALL OF FAME Leland Mortensen

Leland Mortenson of Des Moines,
Iowa, was elected to the IHHPA Hall
of Fame in 1976 and to the NHPA
Hall of Fame in 1971. He became
connected with game and the NHPA
back in 1921 and soon made his mark
as a promoter, organizer and director
of big tournaments. He also became
the recognized historian of the game



in the early years and his articles and writings have
enabled the organization to keep track of events of
the early years, which would have otherwise been
lost. For years he conducted the tournaments at the
large Iowa State Fair and when the NHPA was
unable to hold official World Tournaments in the
years 1936 through 1939, he organized, promoted
and conducted the annual Midwest National in Des
Moines. These tournaments were in every respect
true World Tournaments except for the official
sanction. The events provided a focus and prestige

for the game, which was vitally necessary and enabled the national association to continue.

Leland was instrumental in establishing the NPHA Hall of Fame. He was one of three members who served on the committee to lay the groundwork, establish guidelines and bring their proposal to the NHPA Convention in 1965. In 1966, seven charter members of the NHPA Hall of Fame were elected, including Frank Jackson of Kellerton, Iowa.

Leland passed away October 15, 1978 at age 72.

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

It is time to solicit nominations for our Association's Hall Of Fame and Frank Jackson Awards for 2010.

Hall of Fame Award: The purpose of the Hall of Fame Award is to honor and perpetuate the names of those members who have displayed outstanding ability in the game of horseshoes and/or who have contributed through meritorious service to the general welfare and progress of the game and/or who have pitched horseshoes for a great numbers of years. The successful candidate must receive 75% of the vote cast with a minimum of seven members voting. There can be multiple successful candidates, and there may be no nominee if the 75% vote is not met. Members inducted into this select group consider this to be a great honor, and many continue to promote the sport of horseshoes.

Frank Jackson Award: This award is given to that person who has given effort above the call of duty in advancement of horseshoe pitching in Iowa. Only one successful candidate by majority vote.

Hall of Fame and Frank Jackson Awards are elected by the Hall of Fame Board which consists of the Executive Board of IHHPA, Regional Chairpersons, and a Nomination Committee appointed by the IHHPA President. The nominations for the Awards are from you, the Membership, by submitting a brief description of accomplishments and reasons you feel your candidate deserves the recognition. If you know individuals that fit the criteria for either of the above awards, please send information to me. Include in your nomination their name, how long they have been actively involved with horseshoes, their specific accomplishments and things you feel that make these horseshoe pitchers special. These nominations do not need to be lengthy. In fact, we appreciate nominations that are concise and to the point.

The committee needs your help identifying these individuals so their efforts may be properly recognized. No awards were given in 2009. There are five nominees carried forward from last year; there is no current nominee for the Frank Jackson Award.
