CONDOLENCES

Carl E. Rupe, Sr., of Des Moines died July 17, 2010 at the Veterans Hospital in Des Moines. Carl was a former member of the IHPA and Central Iowa Traveling League. He was a veteran fighter pilot and was buried with military honors at the Iowa Veterans Cemetery. He is survived by seven children. He was predeceased by his son, Daniel Rupe, also a former IHPA pitcher.

C. Leo Buell was born December 20, 1930. He was introduced to horseshoes by his future father-in-law, Cliff Bucknell (also an IHPA Hall of Famer). On Sunday afternoons, Leo would go over to see his future wife, Joan. It wouldn't be long until he was in the yard pitching horseshoes. After he married the love of his life, Leo and Cliff pitched at county fairs and festivals just for the fun of it.

In 1965 in Charles City, Iowa, Louie Kingfield and Alan Kellogg put on a horseshoe tournament on one court in Kellogg's backyard. It took three weekends to complete, but Leo won his first trophy and Cliff came in second.

In 1966, Leo moved his family to Iowa City. Horseshoes pitching was a thing of the past until he read an article in the paper about Art Hampton winning the 1970 State Indoor Championship. Art was contacted and Leo bought his first pair of Ted Allen horseshoes from him. At the same time, Art introduced Leo to the NHPA. As a member of the NHPA, Leo journeyed to Columbus Junction where Jake Davis was holding a tournament. There he met the great ones - - Red Henton, Harold Darnold and Bill Vandegriff. Leo sat in awe and watched them throw ringer after ringer. Mr. Davis' special guest that day was Donnie Roberts, secretary/treasurer of the NHPA.

In 1982, Marianne Colony and Leo organized the Iowa City Horseshoe League. At one time, they had as many as 30 members. Twenty-nine years later the league is still going strong.

In 1987, Leo was elected President of the IHPA and served for four years. After that he served as Area Regional Director of Southeast Iowa until he was elected Chairman of Regional Directors in 1996. Leo has written hundreds of letters over the years to the regional directors, various organizations and individuals, all pertaining to horseshoes.

In 1998, Leo organized the Iowa State Regional Team Championship, patterned after the Team World. There are eight 3-man teams from various corners of the State competing every year on the first Friday of the Iowa State Fair.

In 2000, as a member of the Lions Club, Leo was involved with a program called, "Coming to Your Senses." It was a program to screen and provide early detection of vision and hearing impairment of children from six months to four years. Leo organized a horseshoe tournament with pitchers obtaining sponsors for each ringer or a set amount. 80% of the money

raised went to Coming to Your Senses and 20% went to the NHPA. They raised over \$2500.

In 2005, Leo was inducted into the IHHPA Hall of Fame. In 2007, he received the Frank Jackson award for advancement of horseshoes in the State of Iowa. This year, Leo was awarded the Gene & Mary Van Sant Memorial Award by the NHPA. This award is given to the Regional Director who displays the attitude and initiative in fulfilling his or her duties of upholding the image of the National Horseshoe Pitchers Association.

Some of Leo's many accomplishments include:

- World Class D winner 1978 in Des Moines, 58.8%, winning 10 straight games.
- second in Class B in Iowa State Tournament 1980
- in Preimesberger Arena tournament (World Tournament in Minnesota) hit highest game with 78% hitting 17 ringers out of the last 20 shoes
- was among the top 200 NHPA averages
- throws Ted Allen shoes, three-quarter right hand turn
- has played for over sixty years, forty-five years in tournament play

Leo has submitted his resignation as Regional Director to the Executive Board, but will continue to devote time and energy to the sport. Leo has been very generous donating horseshoes to the drawing at the State Fair for many years. The Iowa City Horseshoe Club hosts the blind veterans for a game of horseshoes each October. As Leo says, you have to be careful with 40 or 50 blind vets throwing horseshoes.

Leo has devoted many years promoting horseshoe pitching in many ways -- In the Iowa City area, as IHHPA President, Chairman of the Regional Directors and being a supplier of Horseshoe Related items for our members. His devotion to the sport of horseshoe pitching could not be greater. Thanks, Leo, for everything you have done for horseshoes and the IHHPA. -- LeRoy Law
