### HORSESHOE LEAGUE PROGRAMS

The NHPA Sanctioned Club/League Program introduces new and veteran horseshoe pitchers to handicap scoring in league play and provides an exciting, competitive, healthful activity for men and women, young and old and physically challenged. The handicap scoring system is designed to give everyone an equal chance to win.

NHPA sanctioned play provides leagues with NHPA insurance coverage, NHPA awards and recognitions, NHPA Junior member patches and scholar awards, full NHPA membership and eligibility to enter any open NHPA sanctioned tournament, and many more member and league incentives.

NHPA award patches include, League Champion, Class Champions, High Game, High Average, High/Over Average, Sportsmanship, and Rookie of the Year; also Most Improved, League Member, and Junior League Member. The NHPA Junior Scholar Award Program recognizes scholastic achievement and appropriate certificates and patches are awarded. High Game averages patches are for 0-5%, 6-9%, 10%, 20%, 30%, 40%, 50%, 60%, 70%, 80%, 90% and Perfect Games. The NHPA Top Ten award program involves national ranking from all NHPA sanctioned leagues,

with national recognition in the NHPA magazine, Newsline.

NHPA bylaws and Official Playing Rules apply. Court construction information is given in the Rules. The NHPA Sanctioned League Program began in 1978 with 13 leagues. The Central Iowa Traveling League joined the NHPA League Program the following season under the leadership of Danny Sease. The Central Iowa Traveling League has been recognized by the NHPA for its longevity, and is one of the few early organized leagues still in existence. Throughout its existence, the CITL has had teams from Adel, Altoona, Ames, Ankeny, Des Moines, Grimes, Maxwell, Redfield, Stuart and West Des Moines. In 2013, the Central Iowa League had six teams - two from Ames, and four from West Des Moines.

In addition, there is league play in Cedar Rapids at Ellis Park; Fort Dodge hosted its first season for league play, and there is a possibility that league play might return to Waterloo.

### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Who was instrumental in getting you interested in pitching shoes? Oh sure, I pitched for fun at a few reunions and with my Father-in-law in my back yard, but I didn't get serious about it until later on. For me, it really started when I heard about a tournament at the Iowa County 4-H fair in July of 2004. It was a partner event and cancellation, so I got Ed Miller (a working companion who won at the last company picnic) to be my partner. It was an extremely hot day so we walked around this little building looking for some shade. To our surprise, two serious looking gentlemen sitting on folding chairs were already occupying 90% of the shade. They had these fancy shoes with big hooks, not anything like the picnic

We won a couple more then lost one while the Professionals won out. It was a double elimination tournament, so were forced to play the Professionals again. **IHHPA HALL OF FAME  
LARRY PURCELL**



**Larry Purcell** of Cedar Rapids was inducted into the IHHPA Hall of Fame in 2013. Larry began pitching horseshoes over 65 years ago. He became a member of the IHHPA in 1986.

Before moving to Cedar Rapids in 1993, Larry lived in Boone, assisting Virgil Williams at the present courts, including installation of the the clay.

In 1997, Larry became active at Ellis Park in Cedar Rapids, assisting Ronnie Burgess in running the tournaments. Larry's experience at the tournament director's table is evident today. He has taught many individuals the necessary procedures to run a tournament.

Larry has worked with Boy Scouts at Summer Camp, and hosts a "Boomers over 50" event along with other horseshoe promotions. He has instructed and given advice, when asked, to many players. He received the President's Award in 2000 for recruiting new pitchers.

Larry pitched in the 40-foot Men's Iowa State Championships, finishing as high as second twice and third once. He has pitched in ten Team World Events held in Beloit, Wisconsin. In 2000, Larry lost a 40-shoe game to Alan Francis by the score of 10 - 19, pitching 77.5% to Alan's 85%. Larry moved to the Elders Division in 2009 and became the 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 Iowa State Elders Champion. At the 2010 World Tournament in Cedar Rapids, Larry tied for second place by win/loss record, and finished in 4th place overall, averaging 74.84%. His highest ringer game was 90%, which he achieved twice in league play, and 87.5% in tournament play.
