### AUTUMN PITCHING

Marengo, Fort Dodge, Indianola, Winterset and West Des Moines held tournaments in late September and early October. The mornings started out cool, but by noon, the weather was ideal. West Des Moines also hosted a Fall league, playing under the lights on Wednesday nights.

On September 20th, twenty-three pitchers played in the "Old Time Classic" in Marengo. The courts were installed less than four years ago under the supervision of Marengo resident and current IHHPA President Ron Stanerson. Larry Purcell of Cedar Rapids won Class A, pitching 72%. Don Burgess of Ottumwa, a long time pitcher and new IHHPA member, won Class B, pitching 45%.

Every September, Rusty and Deb Dalton host the Don Wilson Memorial Tournament in Indianola. Rusty said that over the years, he has seen as many as 30 pitchers and as few as 7 or 8 show up - - "It all depends on the weather." This year, 19 pitchers played on a cool, dewy Saturday morning.

Champion, pitching 69% and defeating Glenn Warden of Grimes who pitched 65%. Glenn previously won Class A in Winterset for three years in a row, from 2010 to 2012.

The threat of rain did not deter 19 pitchers from playing at the Fort Dodge courts on September 20th Marty Sprague holds two tournaments a year as well as league play at the courts that were built on abandoned tennis courts. Marty was recognized at this year's Annual Meeting for his promotion of the sport of horseshoes in the Fort Dodge area.

On October 24th, LeRoy Law looked at the weather forecast and the Hawkeye and Cyclone football schedules and decided to hold a "Spur of the Moment Open." Sending out e-mails and making a few phone calls, LeRoy hosted a tournament the next morning with 14 pitchers at the Holiday Park Courts in West Des Moines. No one was concerned with a conflict between playing horseshoes on a Saturday and watching Iowa or Iowa State football games - - both teams had a bye that day - - and the temperature climbed into the 70's.
