1 egg separated
1/2 T vanilla
1/2 cup sugar mixed with cinnamon (I use lots)

Line 9 x 13 pan with 1 package rolls. Pinch seams together. Mix cream cheese, 1 cup sugar, egg yolk, and vanilla until smooth. Pour over rolls, put 2nd package of rolls on top of mixture. Brush with beaten egg white and sprinkle with cinnamon and sugar. Bake at 350 for 30 minutes




The President's Award was presented by IHHPA Ron Stanerson to Glenn Warden for his service as the IHHPA Chaplain.
