This winter has been the mildest weather we have had, but it would be nice to get some moisture. I would like to use the snow blower once this winter.



IOWANS FINISH HIGH AT MOLINE

Allen Sets Horseshoe Mark

MOLINE, ILL. (AP) - Ted Allen, Alhambra, Cal. successfully defended his national horseshoe pitching title in the tournament which ended Tuesday turning back Harvey Elmerson, Milwaukee, Wis., 50 to 48, in his final match of the round-robin battle to finish with 21 victories and two defeats. Elmerson would have tied the California sharpshooter had he been victorious in their match but Allen proved unbeatable as he hung up a new world's record for consecutive double ringers. wrapping 13 pairs in a row around the stake before missing. Allen earned \$290 for his triumph, \$50 more than Elmerson received for finishing second. The latter's final standing was 19 victories and four setbacks. C. C. Davis, Kansas City, five times world champion, and Guy Zimmerman, Sac City, Ia., wound up in a tie for third, each having 18 triumps against five losses. Casey Jones, the 16 year-old Waukesha, Wis., star who had kept pace with Allen in the early matches, slipped back into fourth place. He shared the position with Frank Jackson, Kellerton, Ia., both having turned in 17 triumphs and six defeats.
