## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

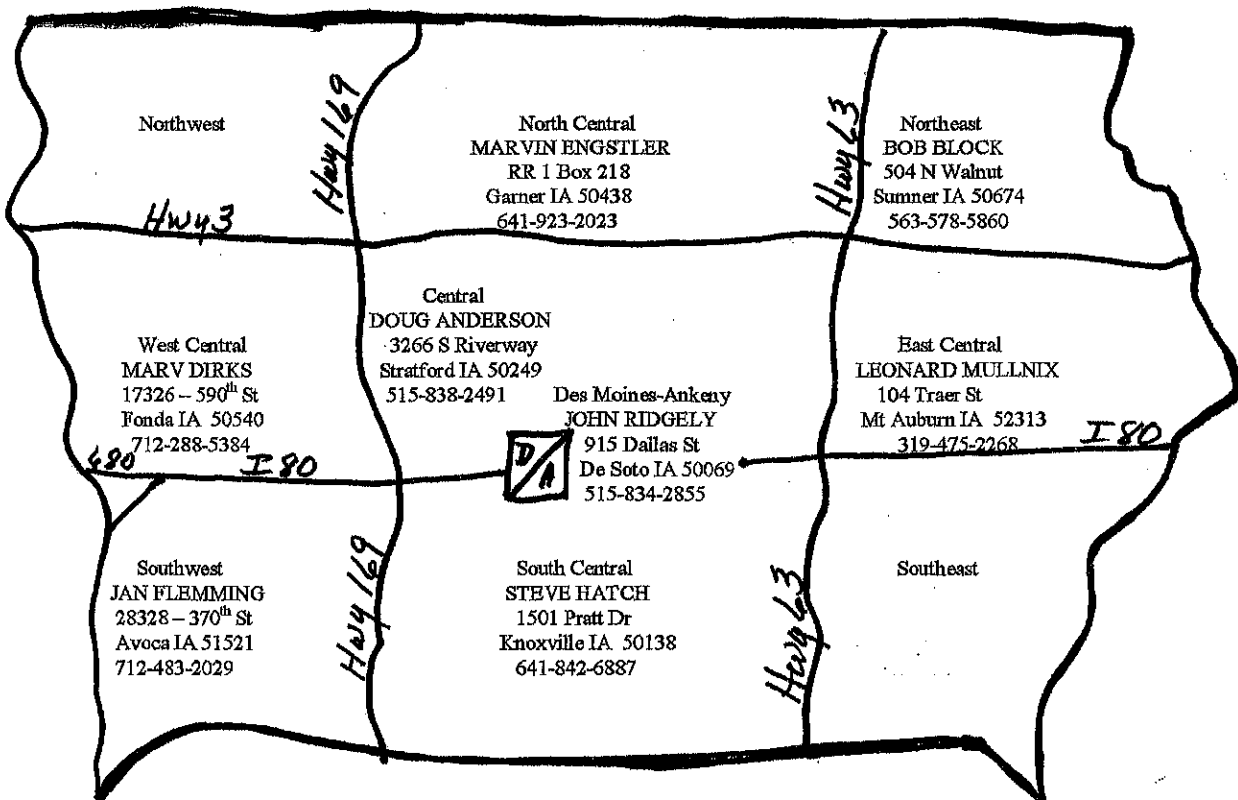

### Greetings from Ames

The 2005 Iowa Games Winter Horseshoe Tournament is in the books. The weather cooperated so all who signed up had no trouble getting to the "games". We even considered going outside and pitching a few---ha. The Iowa Games Staff and Dave Sidles did their superb job as usual and everything went without a hitch---well only a few small ones. We used the computer again to tally the scores, as well as by hand, to be sure, and it worked really well. I wish everybody would look at some output to see all that it provides. As is usual for most tournaments, we saw some cliffhangers and some not so close matches. We let the percentages fall where they may, and did not handicap any classes. The average difference in score over all games was 15 points with 21 games decided by less than 6 points and 7 games by only 1 point. To me, it seemed like the smoothest Iowa Games Tournament we have ever had, including the Summer Games. The 40 individuals that signed up seemed to be really having a good time, especially when they were leaving the kitchen. Thanks so much to the kitchen staff for feeding us royally. Their efforts are greatly appreciated. Because this tournament is non-sanctioned, it is open to anybody, and because of this, some individuals experienced tournament play for the first time. Some even signed on to the IHHPA for 2005. I was really happy to see that.

I should explain that we did not have the usual Seniors tournament on Friday. We did this because of dwindling numbers, and more importantly, because of the third day of pitching on Sunday it creates. We did not want to distract from it. Also, it is not so easy for Dave and I to get up to Eldora for two days.

We did have to scramble for scorekeepers in the afternoon, but were able to fill all the chairs with some "arm twisting". I have seen this in most tournaments, and it is not fair to the afternoon pitchers, because many of them scored during the morning sessions. Maybe in some tournament in the future we will throw pieces of paper into a hat with class designations and draw them out to see which classes pitch when. That would probably be most fair to anybody, but traditional habits are difficult to break.

I have rambled enough for now, but I would invite you to sign up for the Summer Games in Ames in July, especially if you have never participated under the Olympic system. Some of the medal winners this time even got a kiss.

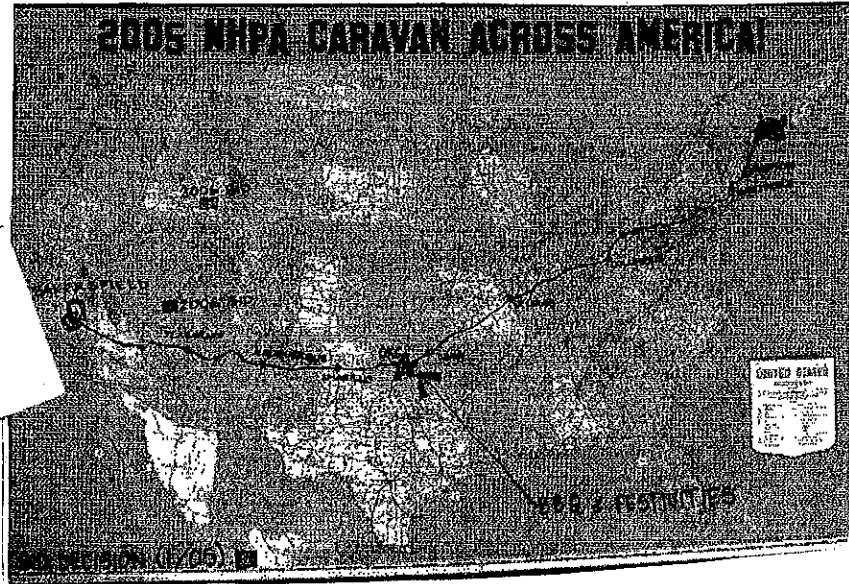
