#### BY-LAW NOTICE

The following proposed By-Law Amendment is to be voted on at the October Annual Meeting:

Line 4 sentence 4 reads: The Statistician shall be compensated three hundred (\$300.00) dollars annually.

Proposed change: The statistician shall be compensated one hundred (\$100.00) dollars annually.

Reason: The Statistician used to send sign-in sheets, summary sheets, results sheets, and percentage sheets of all Iowa pitchers to all Tournament Directors. This had to be sent for each and every tournament. Plus the Statistician had to compile percentages of all Iowa pitchers from tournament results. At present, the Statistician's only job is to send tournament results to NHPA NatStats.

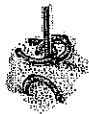
The City of Eldora has resurfaced the nine courts. The Senior Center has been rented for the Tournament.

**'09 WORLD TOURNAMENT BID WRAP UP**

I want to start this wrap up with a message of thank you to: LeRoy Law, Glenn Warden, Leo Buell, Ron Burgess and Larry Purcell. Others extended a helping hand like Mike Fishnick in working the booth at the World Tournament as well as each of you in the support given by our IHHPA. The Cedar Rapids Convention and Visitors Bureau guided us through the process with the leadership of their sports specialist. The path wasn't easy and it was long. Over two years were spent from our original meetings to the World Tournament in Ardmore, Oklahoma. During the process Alabama backed out of the '08 commitment. We gave it a try and the governing board made a decision to go with York, Pennsylvania. We then reset our sights on the delegates voting for the '09 host city at the World Tournament in late July in Ardmore.

Our offering was sound, the budget was in place, and the competition venue had been secured for the dates. Some members of our IHHPA pledged additional prize money as an attraction to increase attendance. The presentation was well planned and presented. Our rivals were Topeka, Kansas and Springfield, Illinois. The delegates chose Springfield. For a few moments, I (and I am sure the others) felt disappointment. Springfield has a wonderful new large convention facility which will be the competition venue; we were going to convert the Cedar Rapids Ice Arena. Springfield's convention center also has an attached hotel, giving a great convenience to the attendees.

My disappointment has faded and I hope that is true of the others. I would like now for us to take the energy we put into the last two years in trying to secure the World Tournament and move forward with improving our horseshoe playing opportunities within our IHHPA. Invest in making our sport attractive to youth, finding sponsors and adding REAL prize money to three or four selected tournaments. My philosophy, "Think about the possibilities and you might get there. Think about the negatives and I know you will get there." How about a roof over the State Fair courts, a tournament for IHHPA members with a \$10,000 purse, junior players being selected for scholarships to further their education.

IN OUR GAME we have a stake at each end of the court. FOR OUR GAME we have a stake in molding its future. Again thanks to all involved. We WILL come out the winners.

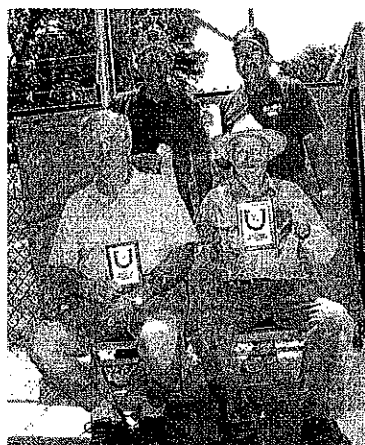

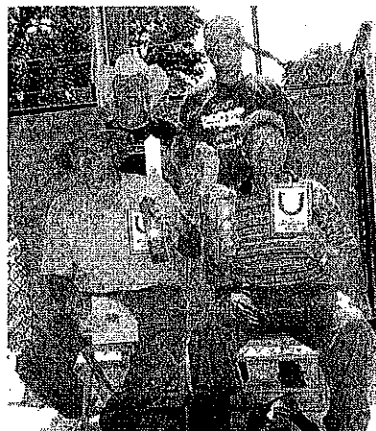
