Others extended a helping hand like Mike Fishnick in working the booth at the World Tournament as well as each of you in the support given by our IHHPA. The Cedar Rapids Convention and Visitors Bureau guided us through the process with the leadership of their sports specialist. The path wasn't easy and it was long. Over two years were spent from our original meetings to the World Tournament in Ardmore, Oklahoma. During the process Alabama backed out of the '08 commitment. We gave it a try and the governing board made a decision to go with York, Pennsylvania. We then reset our sights on the delegates voting for the '09 host city at the World Tournament in late July in Ardmore.

The results of the 40 shoe game were Joe 55 and Larry 13. Joe pitched 25 ringers to Larry's 13.




