

IHHPA HALL OF FAME MARION LANGE

Marion Lange was born in Greene County, Iowa on November 2, 1912. He lived and farmed most of his life near Bondurant, Iowa, before he and his wife, Pauline, retired and moved Ankeny.

In 1924, at the age of 12, Marion started pitching horseshoes with his father with this bit of advice, "If you can't stand to get beat, don't get into horseshoes". Marion was right handed and threw a 1 and 3/4 turn, pitching with Allen shoes.

Marion became a member of the NHPA in 1928 and played in his first tournament in 1928 in Polk County, Iowa. It was there that he met Frank Jackson, first world champion from Kellerton, Iowa.

In 1945 Marion placed second in the Iowa State Championship Class A and from 1945 to 1965 placed second twice; third three times; and in the top five places many times. He won the Iowa State Farmers Championship in 1947 & 1949, and also the Iowa State Open Championship in 1970 & 1971.

Marion participated in four "Class A" World tournaments - 1946, 1954, 1957, and 1960; placing 16th in 1946 at Birdland Park in Des Moines. In 1954 he defeated Ted Allen, World Champion, in the first round of play and finished in 24th place. In 1962 and 1964, he won the Four-State title (Iowa, Missouri, Kansas, & Nebraska) at Falls City, Nebraska with a 75% ringer average. He had a high game of 88% at the Omaha Open.

Marion was President of the IHHPA in 1949, 1950, 1951, and 1952 and again in 1986 & 1987. In 1950 as president, he and Secretary Cunningham of the Iowa State Fair Association, signed a contract for the State Horseshoe tournament to be held at the Iowa State Fair in Des Moines, where it has remained.

He was State Superintendent of Horseshoes from 1973 through 1982 and again in 1985, 1986, and 1987 and during this tenure State Fair entries went from 50 to 700. In 1982 he received an award from the Iowa State Fair Board for recognition of outstanding service to the Iowa State Fair.

Marion received the NHPA "Recognition and Achievement Award" at the World Tournament in Greeneville, Ohio in 1977. He was instrumental in negotiating Des Moines, Iowa as the site for the 1978 World Tournament and was Co-Director of that event.

He was inducted into the IHHPA Hall of Fame in 1978

at the State Fair. In 1982 he received the coveted IHHPA "Frank Jackson Award" for meritorious service.

In 1989, Glen "Red" Henton was given the privilege of presenting Marion to the National Horseshoe Pitchers Association National Convention for his induction into the NHPA Hall of Fame. Marion was inducted as a Player - Organizer category at the World Tournament in Spearfish, South Dakota. He also received a certificate of appreciation for 60 years of contribution in promoting and supporting the sport of horseshoes by the NHPA in 1989 signed by Dave Loucks, President of the NHPA.

Marion was well respected by his fellow horseshoe pitchers and friends. He and his friend, Harold Shaw, another State Champion, played at the World Tournament in Murray, Utah many times. Red Henton met Marion at the Iowa State Championship around 1968. Red said Marion was one of the most formidable, talented players in the sport. Marion and his wife were also fine Christian individuals, a trait that Marion displayed wherever he pitched. He was a fine man, on and off the courts.
