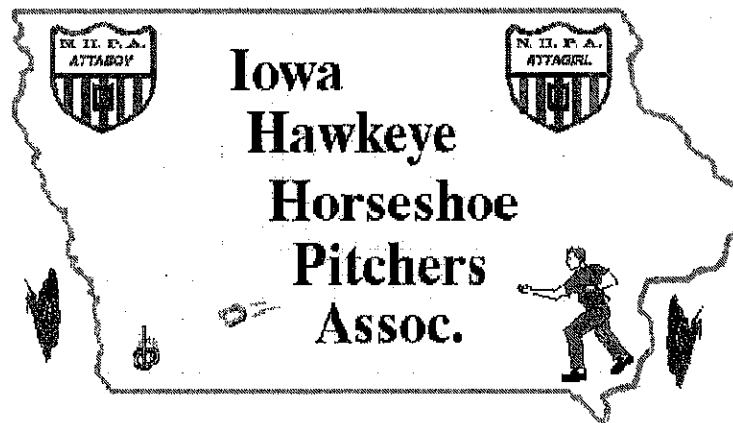

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

2010 WORLD TOURNAMENT TO BE HELD IN CEDAR RAPIDS !! From July 26th to August 7th, 2010 the Ice Arena in Cedar Rapids will be the Home of the 2010 World Tournament. Cedar Rapids was chosen over Little Rock, Arkansas; Pocatello, Idaho; and Lebanon, Ohio. We won the bid on the first ballot, well over the two-thirds necessary. Mary Lee Malmberg, Sports Director for the Cedar Rapids CVB, put together a great presentation and deserves the credit for our success. Winning the bid was the first step. Planning all the details is next and carrying out the many tasks will assure us of a successful World Tournament. It will take everyone of us being involved and it will be a great event for the State of Iowa and for the City of Cedar Rapids. This is an Iowa Hawkeye Horseshoe Pitchers Association World Tournament, one that all of Iowa will support and can be proud of. The last World Tournament in Iowa was held in 1978. It was a success then and we will be successful in 2010 also. States that have hosted World Tournaments have seen a dramatic increase in membership. We need to tell our non-

members about the upcoming World Tournament and encourage them to participate. To enter a World Tournament, one must have played in four NHPA sanctioned events at their division pitching distance during the twelve months preceding the cut off date listed on the entry form. Only one event is required for Juniors. You may want to consider making plans for Springfield, Illinois in 2009, pretty close to home. This will be a challenge for us and will be a labor of love for the sport we enjoy.

2008 NHPA BUSINESS MEETING REPORT There were four By-Law changes proposed and all four passed: 1) The NHPA dues will be increased from \$12.00 to \$17.00. The reason given was that inflation has been averaging 3.5% and NHPA's cost has increased. 1992 was the last year that a dues increase occurred. 2) The minimum bid to host a WT was increased from \$15,000 to \$21,000. 3) Candidates for NHPA office must announce their candidacy in writing no later than February 15th. The previous deadline was March 15th.

4) By-Law amendments can be made every three years. Previously, it was every two years. One NHPA Officer change. Tina Hawkins was elected to fill the 2nd Vice President's position that was held by Casey Sluys. Bob Dunn was selected by President Paul Stewart as the new NHPA Historian Vice President. Stu Sitma reported that eleven tournament sites have shown interest in hosting the 2011 World Tournament.

NOTICE OF 2008 ANNUAL MEETING

The 2008 IHHPA Annual Meeting will be held Saturday October 25th in Marshalltown, Iowa from 10:00 A.M. until conclusion. Location: Moose Lodge - 1516 E. Olive St. Meal will be served. Cost \$12.00. Please notify Ron Rowley so that a meal count can be given to the ladies of the Moose.

NOTICE OF BY-LAW CHANGES ARTICLE 5 (DUES)

Current Language: The annual dues for men and women of this association shall be Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, which includes NHPA current dues and the IHHPA "Newsletter."

Proposed Language: The annual dues for men and woman of this Association shall be Thirty Five (\$35.00) dollars, which includes NHPA current dues and the IHHPA Newsletter.

Reason for Change: At the NHPA Convention in York, Pennsylvania this year, the Delegates approved a \$5.00 increase. The last NHPA increase was in 1992. With inflation averaging 3.5% they sited that their cost of doing business has risen significantly. Despite various cost saving measures and lack of a significant membership increase, our association is facing the same financial situation as the NHPA.

Current Language: Dues for other adult members living at the same address shall be fifteen (\$15.00) dollars, which includes NHPA current dues.

Proposed Language: Dues for other adult immediate family members living at the same address shall be twenty five (\$25.00) dollars, which includes NHPA dues.

Reason for Change: To correspond with new increase and to stipulate that to be eligible one must be a member of the immediate family (spouse or adult son or adult daughter).

Current Language: A player is considered a Junior the entire season if his 17th birthday occurs on or after the start of the calendar year, January 1st.

Proposed Change. A player is considered a Junior the entire season if his 18th birthday occurs on or after the start of the calendar year, January 1st.

Reason for change: Compliance with NHPA Rules. NHPA Playing Rules state any boy or girl eighteen (18) years old or younger for the entire calendar year.

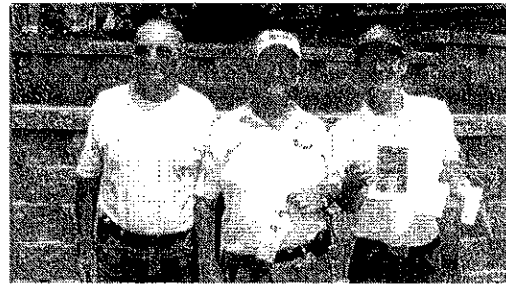
