HHPA HALL OF FAME GEORGE ENGLEMANN

George Englemann was born February 22, 1913, in Spencer, Iowa. George ran the horseshoe events at the Spencer Fair for many years. He was a farmer and part-time government employee.

George threw Allen shoes, one and a quarter turn. He pitched over sixty years, twenty of those years in tournament play. He pitched in the 1978 World Tournament when it was held in Des Moines. His highest average was 50%; highest game 72%. He accrued 119 points in a 50-shoe count-all game at the Buena Vista County Fair.

George was very active promoting, originating and overseeing operations of horseshoe meets. He received the Quad County Horseshoe Award for his services in 1975. He was the Assistant Regional Director Nebraska and Iowa, and a First Vice President of the IHHPA. He was inducted to the IHHPA Hall of Fame in 1977.

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS


