IHHPA HALL OF FAME WOODY WILSON

Woody Wilson was born in 1916 and made his home in Red Oak, Iowa. He was elected President of the IHHPA in 1975 and was inducted to the IHHPA Hall of Fame in 1983.

Woody threw Ohio Pro shoes, tossed a one and a quarter turn, right handed. He won many Class A tournaments. His high tournament was 66.2%, high game 78.7%. Woody pitched in the Intermediate Class B World Champion 1978 in Des Moines and in the Championship division, Iowa State Tournament in 1979. He finished second Class B World Championship in 1980.

Woody became a member of NHPA in 1966. He pitched horseshoes for over 53 years. He and his wife, Vira, had six children - - Robert, Ronald, John, Deanna Hughes, and James.

Woody favored elimination of qualifying and 40 point cancellation at major tournaments. At that time, a player had to qualify at every tournament and the games were 50 points.

Woody is remembered as being a friend to everyone.

Play is governed by the Official Rules of the National Horseshoe Pitchers Association of America. Contestants will pay scorekeepers \$1.00 per game for all NHPA sanctioned events.

Open Singles, Open Doubles, Senior and Amateur events are open to any pitchers from anywhere. Farmers Championship is open to lowa pitchers only. No advance registration is required for these events. Register day of event.

Championship Events (*) require membership in National Horseshoe Pitchers Association. Advance registration is required. Deadline is July 30th. Memberships are available for \$31 from Secretary/Treasurer Ron Rowley (address on page 1).

Averages will be used to determine class placement in various events. Players with no average on record may qualify day of event, time permitting. After a game is completed, a player shall go to the next assigned court and prepare one pit for play.

Method of play in all championship events will be 40-point cancellation or 40-shoes cancellation. Exceptions are in team and handicap where play will be count-all with number of shoes to be announced the day of event. Open events method of play will be announced the day of event. Check entry deadline on each event. No late entries accepted.
