

The NHPA trailer with all the courts and equipment was loaded un on the Sunday following the tournament and was picked up and moved to a secure location in Cedar Rapids for 2010.

The NHPA Business Meeting was held Sunday August, 2^{nd} . Monroe, Louisiana won the bid to host the 2011 World Tournament that will be held July $18^{th} - 30^{th}$. Mary Lee Malmberg and Ralph Palmer headed up the Progress Report for the WT next year. It was a lively report, entertaining and informative. The Delegates approved the NHPA Executive Board's earlier action to grant a Court Sanction Waiver for portable courts that measure less than 31" inside width, but not less than 29" and were built prior to 2007. PROPOSED IHHPA BY-LAW (Pursuant to Article 12 (AMENDMENTS)

The following By-Law Amendment will be acted upon at the Annual Business Meeting:

Add the following language to Article Five (DUES):

Pro-rated dues will be allowed for an Adult or Junior for a specified period of July 1st through December 31st The IHHPA dues for this period would be waived and the individual would pay only the current annual NHPA dues amount (Currently \$17 for an adult and \$5 for a junior). Only new members who have never been a member of the NHPA would be eligible for this Prorated dues period.

Reason: Currently and in the past we have experienced individuals who want to become a member during the second half of the season. When they are told that the membership is not for a twelve month period, that they would have to pay the full annual membership amount or wait for the new membership cards that are available October 1st, they most always wait. Often they never become a member. Only a first time member would receive the opportunity to attend half of the scheduled tournaments for approximately half the annual membership cost.

RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY AT MARENGO COURTS

On July 3rd through the 5th, 2009, Marengo celebrated it's Sesquicentennial (150 years) with many interesting happenings taking place. One of importance to all of us horseshoe pitchers was the ribbon cutting of the six new city courts.

How did this come about, you ask? Well, the Sesquicentennial Committee approached me in 2007 and asked if I would have a horseshoe tournament for the 150th. I agreed, visualizing portable courts in the town square. Somehow it came out the next year that I was having it on July 3rd, 2008. Bob Curry and I scrambled around and made three portable courts and held an evening tournament in the middle of the City Park. The interest was more then we expected, so I had plans made for six sanctioned courts, got cost estimates and went to a City Council meeting. I told the Council if they would provide City land for the project, I would generate the money needed. They gave the "OK."

Fast forward to July 3rd, 2009, at 10:00 a.m. I was standing before a crowd of 150 people with a microphone in hand. I welcomed the Mayor, the Council members, the Administrator, and the special guests. I then had all the Veterans in the crowd step forward and asked them to lead us in the Pledge of Allegiance. Our 1st VP Glenn Warden then led us in prayer. You could have heard a pin drop when he finished. Next, the Mayor cut the ribbon, and then our President, Leroy Law, spoke about the lowa Horseshoe Club and the World Tournament coming to Cedar Rapids.

At 10:30 a.m. I introduced Joe Smith, Vern Kollasch, Leo Buell, Bob Hardy, and Ron Rowley. They, along with Leroy, took to the courts and began pitching. With microphone still in hand, I had them talk to the crowd on

how they held the shoe and what they were throwing (flip, 1 1/4, 1 3/4, etc.) People in the crowd then went to the courts to get tips from our pitchers.


From 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. we had open pitching. From 1:00 to 3:00 we held Pitch & Win.
