IHHPA HALL OF FAME Leland Mortensen

Leland Mortenson of Des Moines, Iowa, was elected to the IHHPA Hall of Fame in 1976 and to the NHPA Hall of Fame in 1971. He became connected with game and the NHPA back in 1921 and soon made his mark as a promoter, organizer and director of big tournaments. He also became the recognized historian of the game



in the early years and his articles and writings have enabled the organization to keep track of events of the early years, which would have otherwise been lost. For years he conducted the tournaments at the large Iowa State Fair and when the NHPA was unable to hold official World Tournaments in the years 1936 through 1939, he organized, promoted and conducted the annual Midwest National in Des Moines. These tournaments were in every respect true World Tournaments except for the official sanction. The events provided a focus and prestige

IHHPA Hall of Fame / Leland Mortenson cont'd for the game, which was vitally necessary and enabled the national association to continue.

Leland was instrumental in establishing the NPHA Hall of Fame. He was one of three members who served on the committee to lay the groundwork, establish guidelines and bring their proposal to the NHPA Convention in 1965. In 1966, seven charter members of the NHPA Hall of Fame were elected, including Frank Jackson of Kellerton, Iowa.

Leland passed away October 15, 1978 at age 72. (from the NHPA Website)

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

It is time to solicit nominations for our Association's Hall Of Fame and Frank Jackson Awards for 2010.

<u>Frank Jackson Award</u>: This award is given to that person who has given effort above the call of duty in advancement of horseshoe pitching in lowa. Only one successful candidate by majority vote.

Hall of Fame and Frank Jackson Awards are elected by the Hall of Fame Board which consists of the Executive Board of IHHPA, Regional Chairpersons, and a Nomination Committee appointed by the IHHPA President. The nominations for the Awards are from you, the Membership, by submitting a brief description of accomplishments and reasons you feel your candidate deserves the recognition. If you know individuals that fit the criteria for either of the above awards, please send information to me. Include in your nomination their name, how long they have been actively involved with horseshoes, their specific accomplishments and things you feel that make these horseshoe pitchers special. These nominations do not need to be lengthy. In fact, we appreciate nominations that are concise and to the point.

The committee needs your help identifying these individuals so their efforts may be properly recognized. No awards were given in 2009. There are five nominees carried forward from last year; there is no current nominee for the Frank Jackson Award.
