He passed away around 11 o'clock that morning at the Henry County Hospital. Doug was a very outgoing type of person. I am told that he went around that morning meeting everyone and remembering their first name. I met him at the

tournaments in Fort Dodge and he was very excited about horseshoes. Our condolences go out to the family from all of us in the horseshoe pitching organization.

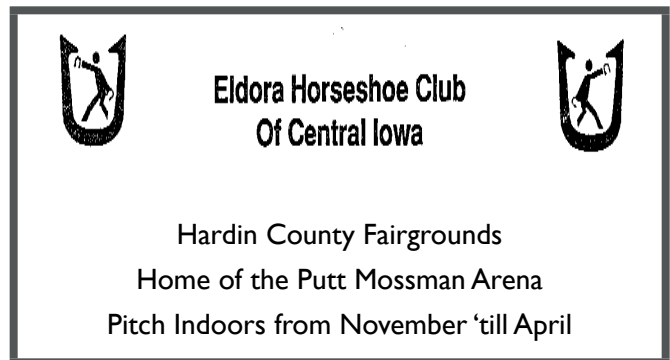
