Mic won the Women's State Indoor Title in 1993. She placed third in Class C at the 1994 World Tournament in Syracuse, New York. She averaged 55% for the tournament.

Mic was predeceased by her husband, Don Wilson. Don was also a long-time member of the IHHPA and had been a past President of the IHHPA

**Ernest "Erney" Soland**, 91, of Soland, died July 15, 2012 at Wellington Place in Decorah. Erney was the tournament director at Decorah. 
