NEW COURTS IN FORT DODGE

On June 1st, Fort Dodge is scheduled to host its first sanctioned tournament on 11 new courts at a new location.

Horseshoes had been pitched on courts that originated in Expo Park. The courts were then moved to Loomis Park in 1978 by Cal Ellis and George Brown.

With the help from Ryan Maehl and the City of Fort Dodge Parks Department, and a grant from IHHPA, an old tennis court at Hydro-Electric Park was converted into 11 horseshoe courts. New pits were installed in the Fall of 2012 and the courts were completed in time for the June 1st tournament. *Continued on page 4*

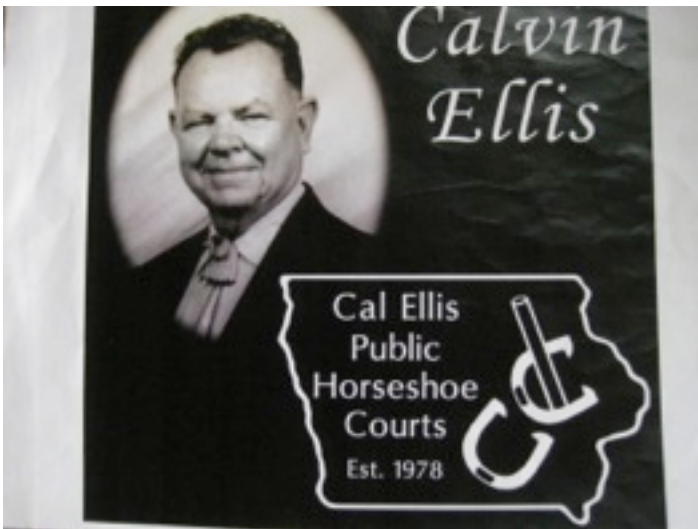

Hydro-Electric Park is located on the West bank of the Des Moines River near First Street Northwest and Fourth Avenue Northwest. There are several walnut trees providing shade over the courts which had to run East/West because of the original fence orientation. The hydro-electric dam and building are still there.

The last tournament played on the Loomis Park Courts was in June, 2012. Calvin "Cal" Ellis was president of the Webster County Horseshoe Club. He pitched at tournaments in Boone, Clay County Fair, Fort Dodge, Webster County Open, and the Iowa State Fair. In 1978, he pitched at the World Tournament. During the Winter months, he pitched in Texas until 2002, when his health no longer allowed him to pitch.

CONGRATULATIONS to Marty Sprague for his hard work in making the new courts a reality. He has organized league play on Tuesday nights, and the IHPA has more than seven new members from the Fort Dodge area because of his efforts.

2013 TEAM WORLD BELOIT, WISCONSIN

The Iowa Team, consisting of Jason Clark, Vern Kollasch, Dick Shephardson, and Joe Smith, competed at Team World in Beloit, Wisconsin over the weekend of May 17 - 19. The Iowa Team finished in 7th place out of 16 teams with 33.5 wins. Iowa was in 6th place after Friday and Saturday; however, the last day Iowa faced some very good teams. All of the Iowa pitchers pitched at least one game over 60%. Vern Kollasch placed 9th with a 12-3 record and 51% ringer average out of 65 pitchers. Dick Shephardson had an 8-7 record and pitched 51.17%. Joe Smith had an 8-7 record and pitched 49.83%. Jason Clark had a 5.5-9.5 record and pitched 48.83%. This was Iowa's best finish in the last three years.

IHHPA STATISTICIAN REPORT CHANGING DIVISIONS/PITCHING DISTANCE

As your Statistician, my main responsibility is to send in the results of tournaments that I receive from the Tournament Directors accurately and promptly. *Promptly* will mean that the player's averages and the number of events played will be posted on NatStats and be up to date. *Accurately* means that I must send in the correct number of ringers and shoes, and I must have on file the current pitching category of the players being reported. Unless a player's new pitching distance/category is reported to me with the Tournament report, I will report to NatStats the information that I currently have on file.

Below are the different pitching categories:

1. **Junior Cadets** - any pitcher twelve years old or younger for the entire calendar year - - - see information on this page from Dan Sanders, NHPA Rules Chairman, as to recent changes to this category.
2. **Junior Boys** - any male pitcher eighteen years old or younger for the entire calendar year
3. **Junior Girls** - any female pitcher eighteen years old or younger for the entire calendar year
4. **Men** - no age restriction
5. **Women** - no age restriction
6. **Elder Men** - become eligible to pitch in the Elders Division upon purchase of an NHPA card dated for the calendar year that they become seventy years old
7. **Physically Challenged Men**

Moving to the Elder category seems to be where most do not know the correct procedure to follow. Below are the applicable NHPA Rules:

Elder Men may pitch from any place on either the extended or full-distance platforms, and shall observe the twenty-seven foot (27') foul line. Elder Men must notify their Charter Secretary, in advance, of the date that they intend to begin pitching from this shorter distance. Once a member declares himself a short distance pitcher, he must remain in that Division until the next year's membership card is purchased. (new this year) At that time he may switch back to the Open Men's Division, but must remain in that Division until the next year's membership card is purchased. Note: See Rule 11, Section D.1 (below) for additional information about re-qualifying.

RULE 11, Section D.1

1. No Current Average - Any contestant without a current ringer average at their pitching distance shall pitch a minimum of one hundred (100) consecutive shoes on a sanctioned court to establish their tournament seeding percentage. This qualifying must be scored in writing

and witnessed by two (2) NHPA members no more than thirty (30) days prior to the entry deadline. Note: This 100-shoe qualifier is not a sanctioned event. Alternately, NHPA Sanctioned League ringer percentage averages may be used if they are based on one hundred (100) or more shoes.

Junior Cadet Age Change and Reminders

You may remember that at last year's convention in Knoxville, the age for Junior Cadet pitchers was changed from 9 to 12 years of age. This means that any Junior pitcher who is 12 years old or younger for this entire calendar year may now pitch as a Junior Cadet and observe the 20-foot foul line. The problem here is that those Junior Cadets who had already moved back to the 30' foul line, and who may now choose to move up to the 20' foul line, will have to re-qualify at this new, shorter distance as per our Rules for changing pitching distances. Also, to be eligible to enter the World Tournament, they must have completed at least one sanctioned event at this new distance before the WT entry deadline. Please see Rule 11, Section D.1 (RGS page 19) for additional information about re-qualifying, or on the NHPA Website at <http://www.horseshoepitching.com>. Please note that this re-qualifier is NOT considered to be a sanctioned event.

COURT SIDE RECIPES

Sheryl Mason of Grinnell brings this treat to the Eldora tournaments. Many of you asked for her recipe.

TIGER BUTTER

1 pound white chocolate or almond bark
1/2 cup chunky peanut butter
1 cup semi-sweet chocolate morsels

Line 15 x 10-inch jellyroll pan with wax paper
Heat white chocolate or almond bark in microwave-safe bowl on HIGH for 1 to 2 minutes or until it melts
Stir until smooth, add peanut butter and microwave on HIGH until it melts
Stir again until smooth and spread mixture evenly into prepared pan
In another microwave-safe bowl, melt chocolate morsels on HIGH until melted
Pour chocolate over peanut butter mixture and swirl through with knife until you get desired effect
Refrigerate several hours until firm and break into pieces

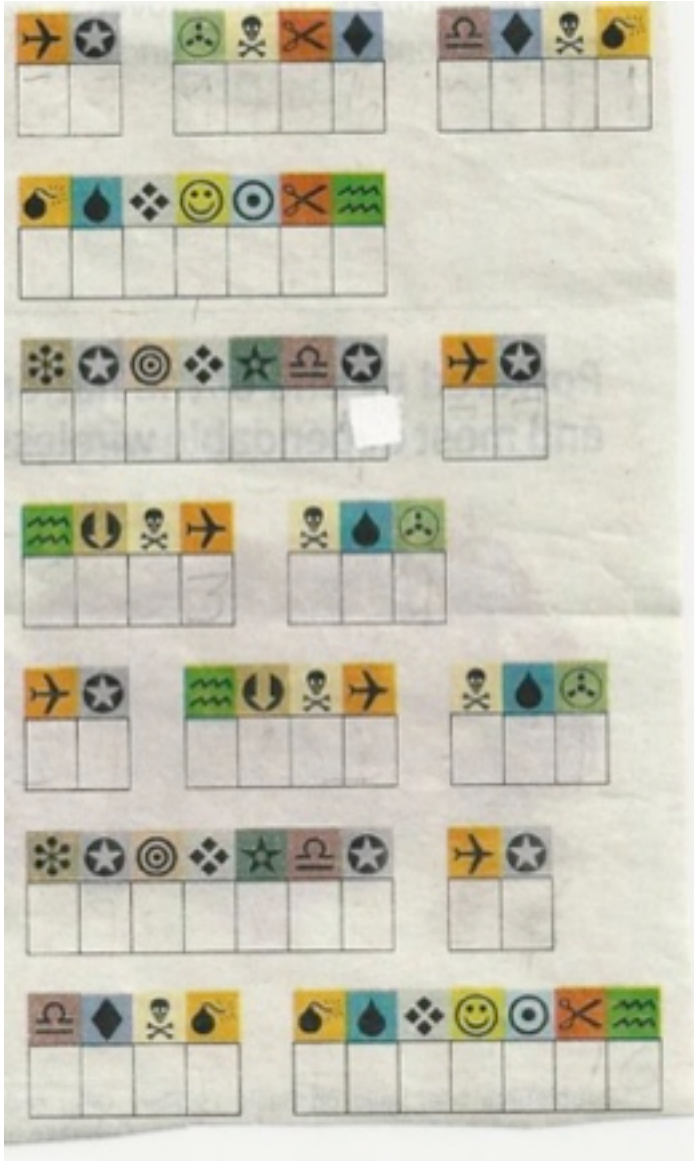

This quote by a British writer can relate to horseshoes as well as to life in general. Letters are represented by the same symbol. Hint: The diamond is a "T." Answer below.

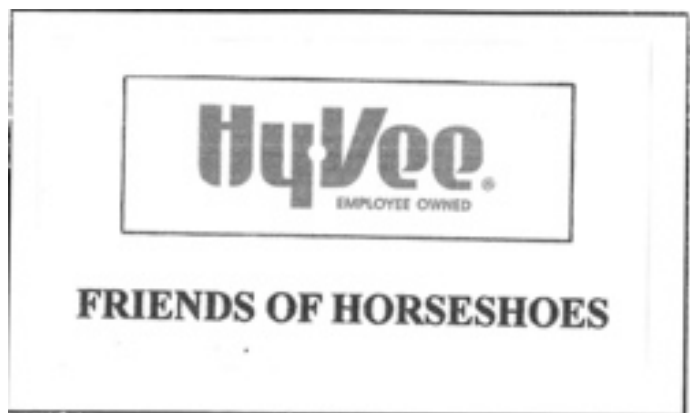
