



Clark finds niche with horseshoes

Sports like baseball and soccer are the norm for most 6- and 7-year-olds exploring the world of athletics.

Malcom Clark of Monticello has done that. But he also decided he wanted to play another game — horseshoe pitching.

And at his young age, he may have found his niche.

"His father learned to pitch horseshoes from perhaps the greatest horseshoe player in the world, Red Henton of Maquoketa," said Malcom's mother, Buffy Clark, "About a year ago, Malcom started playing

with his dad and really liked it."
Malcom Clark, now 7, has won numerous tournaments, many against adult competition. He usually is the only youngster in the competition.

"In horseshoes, competitors are usually broken down by ringer percentage, not age," his mother said. "Malcom averages about 40 percent and has had a high of over 60 at a recent event in Cedar Rapids."

At the Iowa State Fair, which is the only tournament that separates classes

by age, Malcom won the State Junior Cadet division.

Clark pitches shoes for about an hour every day. His 9-year-old brother, Tristen, also throws shoes, but not nearly as often, according to his mother.

"Depending on how far you want to travel, there are tournaments three out of four weekends a month," Buffy Clark said. "During the winter, there are indoor events in El-

dora, which we also try to get to."

The family is unsure how long this

passion will last.

"It's hard to tell what will happen," Buffy said. "Right now, he loves it and wants to continue, but you never know. We will cross that bridge when we come to it."
