#### **ELLIS PARK, CEDAR RAPIDS**



Ellis Park, one of the most historic parks in Cedar Rapids, is located on land donated by Robert Ellis, one of the first settlers on the West bank of the Cedar River. At over 400 acres, it is the largest park in the city.

Ellis Park has eighteen horseshoe courts, all with 40' and 30 foot concrete pads. It is believed that horseshoe courts were part of the original Ellis Park when it was established in the late 1800's, but it wasn't until the early 1930's that the current courts were installed.

There were 12 to 15 courts at Ellis Park when Cedar Rapids hosted the State Tournament in 1939.

In 1987, more courts were added to total eighteen. Lights were added in 2003.

The park also features Ellis Harbor, a unique neighborhood consisting of people who spend their summers living on the Cedar River. The Harbor is open to the public for fishing and bird watching. Other features of Ellis Park include basketball courts, swimming pool, golf course, hiking trail, boating, picnic areas, playground, softball diamonds, and tennis courts.



Faithe L. Walters, 86, of Eldora, lowa, died on Saturday, November 16, 2013 at Ellsworth Municipal Hospital in lowa Falls. Faithe was the wife of the late Bob Walters, past IHHPA President and past Secretary/Treasurer of the Eldora Horseshoe Club of Central Iowa.

Faithe was united in marriage to Bob on April 24, 1949 in Des Moines, IA. They had five children - Gregg, Angie, Gordon, Anita and Chuck.

For many years, Faithe helped prepare and serve lunch at the Eldora Indoor Tournaments. She was well known for her Black Walnut Chiffon Cake. Faithe loved to write poetry and would create verses for special occasions in her or her friends' lives. She wrote the following poem about Bob:

Horseshoes pitchin', oh my lan'
It's completely enveloped my old man.
He pitches high, he pitches low,

Ronald (Ron) McCombs of Dysart, formerly of Cedar Falls, died Saturday, January 11, 2014 at Allen Memorial Hospital in Waterloo.

Ron was born in Waterloo and graduated from Jesup High School. He served 4 years in the U.S. Navy. Ron was employed by Deere & Company as a machinist until his retirement in 2009.

Ron pitched in a lot of tournaments in the early 1980's. He and I worked together in the same department at John Deere. We bowled, golfed and pitched horseshoes together for many years. In 1981 he was one of the original charter members of the Waterloo Metro Horseshoe Pitching League. He and his wife always assisted Dede and I when I ran tournaments in Waterloo and Cedar Falls. He put on a tournament in Jesup during Farmers Day. Ron pitched in his class at the tournament that day and won his class. He pitched as a pacer in Class A and beat everyone in that group, too.

Ron had some health issues and retired five years ago. He tried pitching again in 2010 when I tried to get the Waterloo League going again, but after three games he was pretty exhausted and couldn't continue. He was a good friend and I will miss him. - - Pat Simon

## IHHPA HALL OF FAME MARV WOOLUMS

Marvin Woolums was born near Kellerton, lowa in 1933. Marv served in the Navy from 1955 until 1957 during the end of the Korean War. He worked at the B C & Q Railroad until 1958 when he went to work for lowa Southern Utilities (now Alliant Energy). He started out as a lineman, then became a lineman foreman until he retired in 1996. He was an avid camper and fisherman.

Marv began pitching horseshoes in 1958 and pitched until 1978. He took a break and resumed pitching in 1987. Marv was elected to the IHHPA Hall of Fame in 2003. He was recognized as being a promoter of the game of horseshoes and a great sportsman. For many years, he, along with the late Betty McGregor, would put on a pitching demonstration at the Bill Riley Stage during the lowa State Fair. He introduced the game of horseshoes to students at the Mt. Ayr Junior and Senior High Schools.

Marv was a four-time lowa State Men's Champion, having won in 1999, 2000, 2001 and 2003. He passed away in 2004 doing what he loved, playing horseshoes on the courts in Mt. Ayr.






## COURT SIDE RECIPES CRACKER SNACK MIX - Deb Davis

## PITCH PERFECT: JOHN DEERE HORSESHOES


Blacksmith John Deere made countless shoes for horses in Vermont. But the horseshoes made by a Deere & Company foundry in the 1920s were never intended for horses. They were made for people playing in horseshoe pitching competitions, a very popular pastime in the Roaring Twenties.

Deere & Company research shows the horseshoes were branded with the logo "UMICO," which stood for Union Malleable Iron Co. UMICO was a foundry Deere purchased in 1912 to make castings. In an effort to bring a profitable new product line to Deere, UMICO included this statement in a report from 1921:

The plant has been making malleable horseshoes during the year, and a very substantial volume has been developed. These shoes are being sold in all parts of the country and have met with very favorable reception.


The shoes were advertised through 1924, and an official horseshoe rule book produced at the time included an ad that boasted, "They're going fast.

UMICO horseshoes are selling like proverbial hotcakes. Everybody's pitching 'em! Get your pair now." Another ad in *Playground* magazine from 1923 advertised the horseshoes as a nice reasonably priced present, with satin-finished and nickel-plated shoes priced at \$2 per pair, and enameled shoes at \$1.50 per pair.



These horseshoe pitching rules were distributed by the Union Malleable Iron Co., the manufacturer of UMICO horseshoes. John Deere purchased this company in 1912 and marketed its horseshoes through 1924.
