PROPOSED IHHPA BYLAW CHANGES

Article XII of the Constitution of the Iowa Hawkeye Horseshoe Pitchers Association (IHHPA) states as follows: This constitution and by-laws may be changed, altered or amended in any lawfully called and properly assembled meeting of the association membership only by the affirmative vote of the members present by a two-thirds (2/3) majority. Notice of proposed amendments shall be printed in the IHHPA Newsletter distributed the month prior to the scheduled Annual Meeting of the membership.

The following proposed amendments will be presented to the membership at the October 18, 2014 Annual Meeting:

Proposal #1:

ARTICLE VIII (TOURNAMENT RULES) SECTION 2

Present language: The statistician will furnish all tournament directors with the master summary sheets and player averages plus any other necessary materials prior to the tournament. Tournament directors are to return the master summary sheets and registration sheets to the statistician who keeps accurate statistical records on all members with ringer percentages updated monthly.

Proposed new Section 2 Language: The lowa Chairman of the Regional Directors will furnish all tournament directors with all necessary materials prior to the tournament. Tournament directors are to return the Tournament Results to the IHHPA Statistician following the tournament, either by U.S Mail or by E Mail. The IHHPA Statistician will then record and forward the individual statistics (Players name, Category, ringers and shoes pitched) to the NHPA Statistician who will then enter the players Stats on the Master Nat Stats sheet that is posted on both the NHPA Web Site and on the IHHPA Web Site.

Reason: To reflect what is now the current practice and procedure. Submitted by LeRoy Law.

Proposal #2:

ARTICLE VII (OFFICERS)

Present language: The officers of the association shall consist of a president, four vice presidents, secretary-treasurer, and chairman of the regional directors.

Proposed change to read: The Officers of the Association shall consist of a President, four Vice Presidents, Secretary-Treasurer, and IHHPA Regional Director, Chairman of the Regional Directors.

Reason: For clarification purposes (IHHPA not NHPA). Submitted by LeRoy Law.

Proposal #3:

SECTION 8 (CHAIRMAN OF REGIONAL DIRECTORS)

Present Language: The chairman of regional directors shall appoint the several regional directors of the association, advise them of their various duties and carry out any assigned duties by the president.

Proposed Change: The IHHPA Regional Director, Chairman of the Regional Directors, shall appoint the several Regional Directors of the association, advise them of their various duties and carry out any assigned duties by the President.

Reason: For clarification purposes (IHHPA not NHPA). Submitted by LeRoy Law.

Proposal #4:

ARTICLE VII

(STATE CHAMPIONSHIP REQUIREMENTS)

SECTION 1 (QUALIFICATIONS)

Present language: All entrants to the State Championships must be members of both State and National Associations. Adult pitchers will be placed into the tournament according to their NatStats ringer percent average at the close of a twelve (12) month entry window. Their NatStats record must show participation in a minimum of three (3) sanctioned tournaments during this period. A sanctioned league participant pitching a minimum of 400 shoes will be credited as pitching one (1) tournament. A sanctioned league participant pitching a minimum of 800 shoes will be credited as pitching two (2) tournaments. A sanctioned league participant pitching 1200 shoes will be credited with three (3) tournaments meeting the three-tournament requirement.

Proposed additional language: All previous (40) Ft. Men and Women lowa State Champions, after fulfilling the three tournament participation Rule, will be allowed the opportunity to participate in the Championship Class if he/she desires and shall be seeded in the Class according to their current established Nat Stat Ringer Percentage.

Reason: An optional courtesy given to recognize their past achievement(s). Submitted by Bill Grobstick.

MARENGO HORSESHOE LEAGUE MARATHON



The Marengo Horseshoe League held a 24 – hour Ringer Marathon on July 2nd and 3rd at the City Courts. Sixteen pitchers, pitching one at a time for half an hour, participated in the marathon. The least ringers thrown in a one-half hour period was one, and the most ringers pitched were 90. Pitching started at 9 pm on the 2nd and ended 24 hours later. 1,642 ringers were thrown. Pledges ranged from 1 cent to 15 cents per ringer with only 1,000 ringers counted. Many thanks to the 183 individuals who pledged their dollars as \$4,680 was raised, with half of the proceeds donated to the Marengo Memorial Hospital Foundation. The check is still on display at the hospital.


