The 2015 Iowa Horseshoe Winter Games were held at the Putt Mossman Indoor Arena in Eldora on February 7, 2015. Thirty-seven players from across the state participated in this year's Games.

This was the 15th year that horseshoes were held in Eldora as part of the lowa Winter Games. Bob Walters and John Whalen, the then-Mayor of Eldora, threw out the first pitches in February, 2000. Dick Carlson, Dave Sidles and Jim Hallihan were the 2000 tournament directors.

Eight players who pitched in the inaugural Horseshoe Winter Games in 2000 also pitched in this year's Games. Marvin Dirks, Marvin Engstler, Steve Hatch, LeRoy Law,

Dave Mittlestadt, Russ Martin, John Ridgely, and Joe Smith pitched in the first Winter Games in Eldora and in this year's Winter Games.

The lowa Games are open to all lowa players, sanctioned or non-sanctioned. Gold, silver and bronze medals are awarded to the top three places in each class.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The top ten things to remember when first pitching outdoors in the spring:

- #10 Always start mowing around the pits... blow the clippings away from the clay.
- #9 Pitch only on windy days... in the city the clanking noise sounds one block over.
- #8 If you pitch better in the rain, it's harder to find competition.
- #7 Pitching at night requires lighted stakes.

- #6 Hail hurts!
- When grilling you must turn the steaks after 36 shoes.
- 44 Quick shoe releases are better when lightning is near.
- #3 Shoes pitched too high increase the chance of eliminating the first Robin.
- #2 Put ringers on solid...spinners vibrate the ground bringing night crawlers to the surface.
- #1 Wearing shorts for the first time can blind the neighbors.

FROM THE NHPA

The 2015 World Tournament will be held July 13 -25 on fifty indoor clay portable courts in the air conditioned Expocentre in Topeka, Kansas. The two-week world tournament is held each Summer to crown class champions

and overall World Champion horseshoe pitcher in each of eight divisions – Men, Women, Senior Men (60+), Senior Women (60+), Elder Men (age 70+), Junior Boys & Girls(13-18) and Junior Cadets (12-and under). Pitchers will be competing for approximately \$200,000 in prize money, trophies and scholarships, as well as the right to call themselves "World Class Champion."

Participants will pitch three days (approximately five games will be played each day). Top qualifiers will advance to the championship round. We are expecting 1200 total entrants from the United States, Canada and several other countries.

To participate, you must be a current member of the NHPA, and have participated in a minimum of four NHPA sanctioned tournaments prior to May 15 2015. All NHPA sanctioned tournaments seed entries by their ringer average so you are always pitching with other folks who have about the same ringer average or skill level as you. Entries must be postmarked by May18, 2015. Entry Forms are available at the NHPA website.
