Two teams from lowa competed in the 2015 Team World in Beloit, Wisconsin May 15 to May 17. Iowa #1 finished in 8th place and Iowa #2 finished in 11th place out of 20 teams. A total of 88 players participated. Glenn Warden of Iowa Team #2 finished in 4th place overall, with 17 wins and 2 losses, averaging 62.5%. Missouri #1 won the tournament with a total of 68.5 wins, averaging 63.98% as a team.

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

It is time to solicit nominations for our Association's Hall of Fame and Frank Jackson Awards. Deadline for nominations is July 15, 2014.

Hall of Fame Award: The purpose of the Hall of Fame Award is to honor and perpetuate the names of those members who have displayed outstanding ability in the game of horseshoes and/or who have contributed through meritorious service to the general welfare and progress of the game and/or who have pitched horseshoes for a great number of years. The successful candidate must receive 75% of the vote cast with a minimum of seven members voting. There can be multiple successful candidates, and there may be no nominee if the 75% vote is not met. Members inducted into this select group consider this to be a great honor, and many continue to promote the sport of horseshoes.

Frank Jackson Award: This award is given to that person who has given effort above the call of duty in advancement of horseshoe pitching in lowa. Only one successful candidate by majority vote.

Hall of Fame and Frank Jackson Awards are elected by the Hall of Fame Board which consists of the Executive Board of IHHPA, Regional Chairpersons, and a Nomination Committee appointed by the IHHPA President. The nominations for the Awards are from you, the Membership, by submitting a brief description of accomplishments and reasons you feel your candidate deserves the recognition. If you know individuals that fit the criteria for either of the above awards, please send information to me. Include in your nomination their name. how long they have been actively involved with horseshoes, their specific accomplishments and things you feel that make these horseshoe pitchers special. These nominations do not need to be lengthy. In fact, we appreciate nominations that are concise and to the point. The committee needs your help identifying these individuals so their efforts may be properly recognized.

Ray Daugherty of Council Bluffs was the 2014 Hall of Fame Inductee. Other IHHPA Hall of Famers are Ralph Palmer and Larry Purcell (2013); Joe Smith and Owen Simmons (2012); Keith Baker (2011); LeRoy Law (2008); Harold Garner (2007); Leo Buell (2005) and Marv Engstler (2004).

Past winners of the Frank Jackson Award are Deb Davis (2014); Steve Ronk (2012); James Jackson and Stoney Jackson (2011); Bob Bown (2008); Leo Buell (2007); Dave Sidles (2006); Bob and Marian McKee; (2005); Mic Wilson (2005); and Gerald Weeks (2002).

All nominees from last year are eligible in 2015 and 2016 if not successfully elected.


CONDOLENCES

Dozens of blood donors came out on March 16th to give O-negative blood. LifeServe of Iowa sponsored the drive along with WHO Radio's Van and Bonnie. O-negative blood is sought after as it is a universal type and can be used in trauma situations and for newborns. Medical helicopters carry O-negative as it can be used on any patient. Only 6 per cent of the population has O-negative, so getting donations of this type can be difficult.

IHHPA LeRoy Law of West Des Moines came in to donate. "Knowing that not only type O negative is needed, a lot of blood is needed for cancer patients, they have a lot of infusions of blood, they need that," said Law.

Nationally only 38% of people are medically eligible to donate blood and only 10% of the population actually donate. About 1 in 7 people who enter the hospital are in need of blood.
