### 90 IS THE NEW 60

On a Saturday morning in April, Russ Martin, Roger Roberts, Gary Hinrichs, and Carl Kaiser traveled to the horseshoe courts in Eldora to play in the Burgess Family Memorial Tournament.

Russ Martin has been a past president and secretary-treasurer of the IHHPA, and is a member of the IHHPA Hall of Fame. He was at one time listed in the top 100 men pitchers in the NHPA. Roger Roberts became a sanctioned pitcher less than ten years ago, and has won several class champion patches at Eldora. During the Summer months, he pitches league at the courts in Charles City. Gary Hinrichs has played in every NHPA World Tournament since 2010, plays in the annual lowa Winter Games, the lowa Senior Games, and pitches in a league in Marengo. Carl Kaiser, a former track star from East Des Moines High School, is a member of the IHHPA Hall of Fame, and has been the winner or contender for the "Most Tournaments Played" award for many years. Carl also pitches in the lowa Games and in a weekly league.

In Eldora, each of them pitched 200 shoes – five 40-shoe games in a six-person class. The tournament started at 10:00 and ended over two hours later. On that day, Gary Hinrichs and Russ Martin won their respective classes.

Each of these four men is 90 years-plus young. When they were 70 years of age, they were eligible to move up ten feet and throw from the 30-foot line. Russ Martin pitched from 40 feet until his mid-80's. Carl Kaiser continues to pitch from the 40-foot line.

Missing from the April tournament was Carl Krukow, who is also in his 90's. Carl has pitched in four World Tournaments

and plays regularly at tournaments throughout lowa, including Eldora. He won his class at the 2015 Burgess Family Memorial Tournament. *Continued on Page 4*

### **CALL FOR NOMINATIONS**

It is time to solicit nominations for our Association's Hall of Fame and Frank Jackson Awards. Deadline for nominations is July 15, 2016.

Hall of Fame Award: The purpose of the Hall of Fame Award is to honor and perpetuate the names of those members who have displayed outstanding ability in the game of horseshoes and/or who have contributed through meritorious service to the general welfare and progress of the game and/or who have pitched horseshoes for a great number of years. The successful candidate must receive 75% of the vote cast with a minimum of seven members voting. There can be multiple successful candidates, and there may be no nominee if the 75% vote is not met. Members inducted into this select group consider this to be a great honor, and many continue to promote the sport of horseshoes.

Frank Jackson Award: This award is given to that person who has given effort above the call of duty in advancement of horseshoe pitching in Iowa. Only one successful candidate by majority vote.

Hall of Fame and Frank Jackson Awards are elected by the Hall of Fame Board which consists of the Executive Board of IHHPA. Regional Chairpersons, and a Nomination Committee appointed by the IHHPA President. The nominations for the Awards are from you, the Membership, by submitting a brief description of accomplishments and reasons you feel your candidate deserves the recognition. If you know individuals that fit the criteria for either of the above awards, please send information to me. Include in your nomination their name, how long they have been actively involved with horseshoes, their specific accomplishments and things you feel that make these horseshoe pitchers special. These nominations do not need to be lengthy. In fact, we appreciate nominations that are concise and to the point. The committee needs your help identifying these individuals so their efforts may be properly recognized. Carl Kaiser and Darrell Nation were the 2015 Hall of Fame Inductees. Other IHHPA Hall of Famers are: Ray Daugherty (2014) Ralph Palmer and Larry Purcell (2013); Joe Smith and Owen Simmons (2012); Keith Baker (2011); LeRoy Law (2008); Harold Garner (2007); Leo Buell (2005) and Marv Engstler (2004).

Past winners of the Frank Jackson Award are Deb Davis (2014); Steve Ronk (2012); James Jackson and Stoney Jackson (2011); Bob Bown (2008); Leo Buell (2007); Dave Sidles (2006); Bob and Marian McKee; (2005); Mic Wilson (2005); and Gerald Weeks (2002). There was no recipient of the Frank Jackson Award in 2015.

All nominees from last year are eligible in 2016 and 2017 if not successfully elected.

Other current IHHPA members who are 90+ years are Keith Baker, Slim Allen, Terry Shea, Verl Sims and Glen "Red" Henton.

Keith Baker is a member of the IHHPA Hall of Fame. He has participated in several sports in the lowa Senior Games - - horseshoe pitching, pool, and football toss. He has also pitched in the lowa Summer Games and the lowa State Fair Championships.

Slim Allen played regularly during the lowa State Fair in the ISF Seniors Championship and Midwest Seniors Classic, and was always a top contender. He was a member of the State Fair Doubles Championship team three times when he was in his 80's.

Terry Shea pitches in the Council Bluff area, playing at the courts at Sunrise Park since the 1980's, and in the indoor league. Terry also pitched at the Iowa State Fair tournaments.

Verl Sims plays league during the summer months at the Holiday Courts in West Des Moines.

Glen "Red" Henton is the senior member of this elite group. He is a World Champion, Iowa State Champion, member of the NHPA Hall of Fame and IHHPA Hall of Fame. "Red" continues to hold exhibition tournaments throughout the state, and visits the courts at the Iowa State Fair every year.

The Elders Division (men 70 years and older) is the fastest growing division of the NHPA. In 2015, at the NHPA World Tournament in Topeka, Kansas, a proposal to lower the eligible age of the Elders Division from 70 to 65 was defeated, in part because there are so many current members pitching well into their 70's, 80's and 90's.





### MWD Celebration.

This is a five day celebration in Waterloo, beginning on Wednesday evening and concluding on Sunday evening. The Horseshoe exhibition/tournament is on Saturday only. ### Admittance Buttons.
