

The 2016 IHHPA Annual meeting will be held Saturday, October 15, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. at the VFW Lodge, 108 N. Center, Marshalltown. Offices up for election are: Secretary/Treasurer, Second Vice President and Fourth Vice President. The positions of Statistician, Public Relations Officer and Youth Director are also up for election. Below are proposed amendments to the current By-laws which will be presented to the membership for approval or rejection. Contact Deb Davis to pre-register 515/778-5932 or e-mail ddand2dogs@msn.com. Cost for dinner is \$15 per person. 2017 membership cards will be available. You can pay in advance for your dinner and 2017 membership on the IHHPA website using PayPal.

Article XII (Amendments) of the IHHPA By-laws state, *This* constitution and by-laws may be changed, altered or amended in any lawfully called and properly assembled meeting of the association membership only by the affirmative vote of the members present by a two-thirds (2/3) majority. Notice of proposed amendments shall be printed in the IHHPA Newsletter distributed the month prior to the scheduled Annual Meeting of the membership. Following are proposed amendments to the current By-laws:

Proposed Amendment #1: Add the following language to Article V (Dues):

A member of the Iowa Hawkeye Horseshoe Pitchers Association (IHHPA) who has reached 50 years of membership shall be granted a lifetime membership to the IHHPA in addition to a lifetime membership to the NHPA. Lifetime members will not be required to pay NHPA or IHHPA annual dues. Benefits for lifetime members will include, but are not limited to, a lifetime NHPA membership card and a lifetime subscription to the IHHPA newsletter. – submitted by Deb Davis.

Proposed Amendment #2:

ARTICLE VI (COMPENSATION) Present Language:

The president of the association shall be compensated one hundred (\$100.00) dollars annually. The secretary-treasurer shall be compensated three hundred (\$300.00) dollars annually. The editor of the newsletter shall be compensated three hundred (\$300.00) dollars annually. The statistician shall be compensated one hundred (\$100.00) dollars annually. All other officers shall receive reasonable and just reimbursement for expenses, such as postage, subject to council approval. Proposed Change:

Increase all annual compensated positions listed above Fifty Dollars(\$50.00)

Reason: There has not been an increase in some time. The responsibility and time involved warrants an increase in compensation. – submitted by LeRoy Law.

Proposed Amendment #3

ARTICLE IV (OFFICERS) and ARTICLE VI (COMPENSATION)

Proposed changes:

(1) Insert the following as SECTION 9 under Article IV and increase the subsequent Section Numbers).

SECTION 9 (IHHPA WEB MASTER)

The IHHPA Web Master shall:

1. Maintain the IHHPA Internet website under the direction of the Executive Council.

2. Work with the IHHPA Executive Board and Publicity Director to include items of interest to the general membership and casual observers.

3. Work with the Newsletter Editor in displaying the IHHPA newsletter.

4. Resolve problems that may arise or contact the Web Site Designer, or other support individual, to correct and resolve Web Site Problems that may arise.

5. The IHHPA Web master shall be elected to a two-year term, the election to be held in even numbered years.

(2) Add the following to Article VI (Compensation): *The IHHPA Web Master shall receive One Hundred Dollars*(\$100) *in compensation annually.*

Reason: After experiencing major problems with our old Website and not having the technical support to update and resolve those problems, it is evident that having a person in this position to accomplish the intended purpose of establishing a continuing updated website is needed to oversee and instruct others is needed. The time involved warrants the compensation. – submitted by LeRoy Law.

Proposed Amendment #4:

ARTICLE IV (OFFICERS) SECTION 7 (SECRETARY-TREASURER) (Present Language)

The secretary-treasurer shall keep an accurate record of the minutes of all meetings, act as custodian of the funds of the association, and keep accurate financial records of funds received and distributed. The secretary-treasurer shall submit financial records at all regular and special meetings and meet with the auditing committee to insure that financial records are in order prior to the annual meeting. Two signatures will be required on the checking account with only one required for withdrawals – one signature the secretary-treasurer and the other the president. Once a month a person designated by the president will reconcile the checkbook at the home of the secretary treasurer.

Proposed change: Delete "Once a month a person designated by the president will reconcile the checkbook at the home of the secretary treasurer and replace with: The IHHPA President shall designate a person, committee or Firm to Audit all financial documentation once a year before the IHHPA Annual Meeting. In addition, The Secretary/Treasurer will send a copy of the IHHPA Monthly Bank Statement to the IHHPA President for his/her review.

Reason For change: The present language that would be removed is not and has not been done for years. The proposed language would include reconciling the Checkbook and reflects the procedures that are in place currently. – submitted by LeRoy Law.

Proposed Amendment #5

ARTICLE IX (GAME RELATED ITEMS)

Current language: <u>Game related items to be sold at any</u> tournament shall be handled in a separate account for that purpose. The president may appoint a game related items chairman. The auditing committee shall audit the financial accounts once a year prior the annual meeting.

Proposal: Remove this Article from the Bylaws in its entirety.

Reason: Game Related Items can be purchased on-Line. We do not have a separate account for that purpose, a Game Related Items Chairman nor would there be an Audit conducted. - - submitted by LeRoy Law
