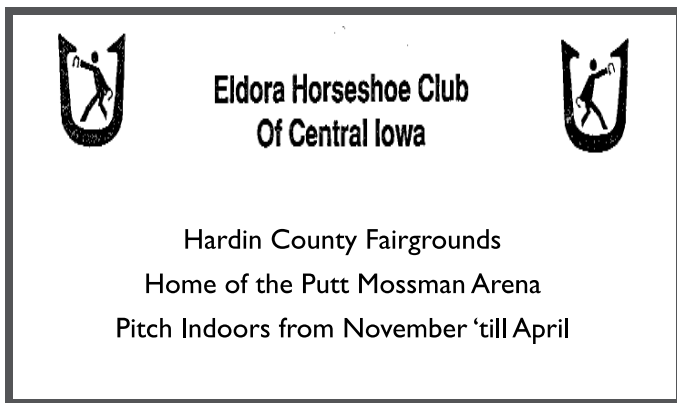

MARENGO HORSESHOE LEAGUE

The Marengo Horseshoe League is a sanctioned league. Our league starts in May with open pitching on Monday and Tuesday evenings. In late May, we are placed in teams of three, with each team generally made up of a high, medium and entry level ringer percentage player. Participants pick what is best for them, either Monday or Tuesday evenings, with play beginning at 6:15 p.m.

The official league season begins in June and runs through August. We play with four teams on Mondays and four different teams on Tuesdays, using 40 shoe count all scoring and a handicap system. All stats required by NHPA are kept in an Excel format and reported at the season's end. If you have followed correctly, you see that is a total of 24 players. If others want to play, we can use them as subs or run a second shift with additional teams because we have court lights. In the summer of 2017, we had 7 men, 5 women, 10 elders, and 2 juniors. 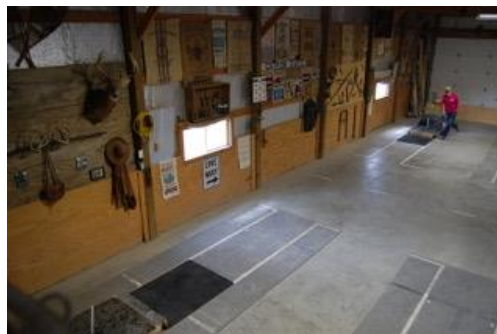

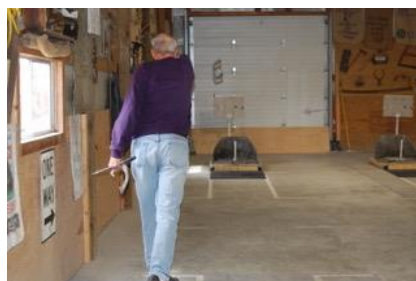
